Meeting Minutes January 2020

- Meeting opened by Kay Dahlquist
 - Seven members had perfect attendance in 2019. Sherry Book, Michele Hayden, Vicki Johnson, Tammy Kratky, Lynn Morgan, Nancy Muecke, Donelle Olsen, and Diane Schlotman
 - There was no newsletter in Jan, so Kay read her New Year's Letter to the guild.
 - Three thank you notes were received. Karen Kuenas family, Sioux City Schools, and the Warming Shelter.
 - Guests: Robert Jaminet and Sister Shirley
 - New members: Brenda Olson, Natalie Hsu, Mary Barton
 - Monica Holland read Dec minutes
 - Treasures report: \$18,138.20. We need to spend some money.
 - Monthly mini by Kay Minor. Won by Cindy Grimm. Kay Minor didn't attend. Will get monthly mini to Cindy later.
 - Feb monthly mini by Mary Baklund
 - Any news for the newsletter get to Sharon Bobier by the 1st of the month.
 - Sharon will post any classifieds from guild members only at no charge. Send to her email; ggmasunny@hotmail.com
 - Mary Baklund will update the membership roster. Will have done in March.
 - Need helpers for Girls Inc. Tues 6-7. Last two Tues in Jan needs help. Feb, Mar, and April left to fill.
 - The Sweat Shop is August 29th. Tammy Kratky showed an example of a quilt top we could make consisting of 47 jelly roll strips. Papers with monthly strip donations was passed out. If we all donate some each month, kits can be made and sewing will be smoother on the 29th. Strips WOF 2.5". Groups of 5-6. 1 foot section cut off ends and alternate sides.
 - Tammy explained the Sweat Shop. Donation quilts made the same year as our quilt show.
 - Tammy will present the program in Feb. Organizing our quilting paperwork.
- Bring your papers to the Feb meeting, binders will be available.
- Mary Pointer sends out cards when needed. Let her know if you need a card sent to someone.
 - Hand quilters and Appliquers meet the 4th Thursday. 4:30-7. Sunrise. 5501 Gordon. Enter door marked 5501. Receptionist will guide you to the right room. Bring you projects and snacks to share.
 - Alyce King takes care of Sunshine quilts. Ask her if you need batting. Guild will take quilts of any size and or bakings. Kay asked that we start a notebook documenting donations. These quilts are given to the police, fire dept, burn unit, hospital, tornado victims, etc. average size is 40x45, 50x50. Not bed size. Lap size. Can be made from any fabric.
 - Sherry Book reported she received 64 hats, 68 mittens, 3 scarves, socks, and a pair of slippers. She will accept donations all year. Items were distributed to Sioux City schools, Center for Domestic Abuse, and Sunrise Retirement.
 - Lois Pirozek received 32 stockings. Distributed to St Luke's, Mercy, and the Foster Closet.
 - Lois also said Hospice is now a level 5. Need all the banners for vets that you want to give.
- Tentative Plans for 2020 guild meetings:**

- Larry Cope from Hawarden requested the next quilt show be held at their venue. Price would be \$800. Guild decided it was too early to decide. Show chairs are not even formed. Will table until later.
 - Get your Bucket List lists to Lois by Jan 31. Awards will be announced in Feb.
 - Sioux Centers quilt show is in May. Need any quilts from the swap to be shown in their show.
 - Carol J. Holling retreat is Oct 23-35. Sign ups on back table. Spaces for guild members until June and then opened for non guild.
 - Vicki Johnson delivered 8 quilts to Hope Street Sober House. Located across from Heelan. Need two more quilts 60x90. Program is run by a grant. The men must work, be clean and do their own cooking. 2 men per room.
 - The guild can receive 5\$ per subscription to Fons and Porter magazine. Will put out a sign up to see if there is any interest.
 - Program was Sister Shirley Finnegan from Lila Mae's House. She explained the program for Sex Trafficked persons in our area.
 - Meeting closed and show and tell.
