The UPC off any package of Hobbs Batting is eligible. She depends on membership donations of the UPCs. The UPCs are used on her order form for the Guild's benefit. When a new roll is needed, she is able to order it using the UPCs to give us the price break. The next time you open a new package of Hobbs Batting, please cut out the UPC and give it to one of us.
