May Program and Upcoming Events

I'll have hand-outs for Block D and the **layout of the blocks** for the Mystery Patriotic Table Runner at the May meeting. The Block D is attached to this newsletter.

On May 9, we finally meet our guest from Mission SD. Vi Colombe specializes in traditional lone star quilts of the many Sioux people. Every one of her Star Quilts are unique. She'll present a trunk show and give us some history of how the lone star became the traditional motif of the Sioux nations. A group of about 10 sewing and quilting women from Winnebago will be visiting to enjoy Vi's program. We've also alerted the Cherokee Quilt Batts and Dakota Prairie Quilt Guild about the program. We hope some of them will visit us. Because we've invited others to come, we are asking each member to bring a half dozen cookies to share after the program. We will provide lemonade, cups, plates, and napkins. If you aren't a baking enthusiast, purchasing cookies is fine. Please join in.

For the June 13th meeting we would like to have a little show 'n tell for your Patriotic Table Runner in honor of Flag Day. It only needs to be put together in the final layout. Then, once you've had time to quilt and bind it, bring it back for show 'n tell at the July meeting. Also, for June 13th, we will be having a game of Fold it - Snip it - Rip it - Pass it Dare. Bring a yard of a fabric you like (you'll be keeping 1/2 yard of it). Also bring a little snip or scissor with you to do the snipping. Bring a bag to place your cuts into. The Dare will be to make something incorporating all of your fabric pieces. Perhaps we can have a show 'n tell of your creations for the December meeting?

Courtenay Hughes class, Lone Star Celebration, is scheduled for Saturday, June 25th. Courtenay is the Sewing Studio Manager for Missouri Star Quilt Company. She has a class on Craftsy called Luminous Lone Star, travels often, and has done numerous FB Live videos for MSQC. There are no special rulers or templates required. Courtenay's class limit is 20 students. In addition to the attachment on the newsletter, Christine will have registration forms for serious participants at the meeting. Deadline for submitting your registration with payment is May 16th. If you can't commit at the May meeting, you may mail your check to our PO Box to reach us by that deadline date. The fees are \$40.00 for SSQG members and \$50.00 for non-members. I'll provide a supply list upon receipt of your registration and payment.
