¼ yard contrast fabric

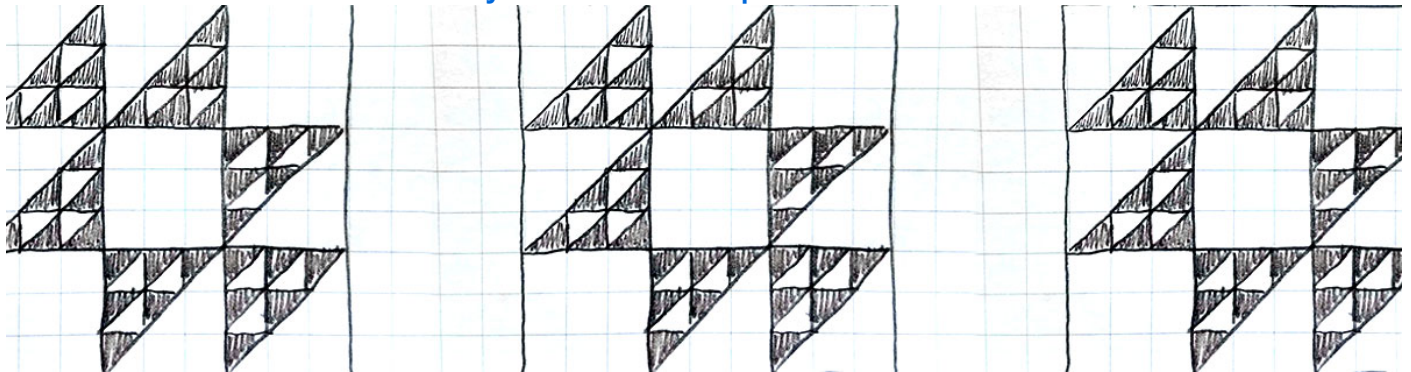
2/3-yard background fabric
