

Veteran's Banner

Cut four pieces of red fabric 2" X 15"

Cut three pieces of white or beige fabric 2" X 15"

Sew together on the 15" side starting with red for the bottom of the banner

For the top part of the banner cut a blue piece 7 ½" X 11 Or whatever width fits the bottom part of banner. Sew the striped piece to the blue fabric

Applique the white or beige star on the blue background in desired technique.

Cut backing and batting to fit the pieced top. Quilt as desired and bind, or you can use the birthing method (right sides together laid on top of batting and sew all around. Leave an opening to turn). Quilt as desired.

Sew plastic ring on the back for hanging.

Finished banner size approximately 10-11" 23-25" If you want to make it scrappy go ahead. I made this pattern simple, easy and something a beginner can do to honor a veteran. Hospice of Siouxland thanks you in advance for your time.
