2. In order to be eligible for a High Point Award at year end, an exhibitor must have participated in a minimum of (any) **3 Sanctioned Shows** during the Show Season.

3. Any combined Mare/Gelding/Stallion Class will be counted separately towards the Mare, Gelding, and Stallion Awards in all three divisions. Points will be based on the adjusted class placement of Mares only vs. Geldings only vs. Stallions only in those classes.

Pre-entries must be emailed or mailed. A copy of the horse's registration papers, both front and back, must accompany the pre-registration for it to be valid. You may pre-enter each horse in as many classes as you wish, but only one pre-entered class is required in order to receive the pre-entry price of \$35 on all subsequent classes for that horse. Pre-entries will be accepted until 4:00 PM on Thursday, August 31, 2017. Entries received after 4:00 PM on August 31 will be charged the \$40 entry fee. Entries not received by 4:00 pm on August 31, must bring their horse's original registration paper for a copy to be made at the show office, or bring a copy of the front and back to leave at the show office. ALL entries MUST have complete information including addresses with zip codes, riders card number, and RMHA membership number. No payments for pre-entries are to be sent, all class fee payments will be made at the show. Stalls must be paid for at the time of reservation through the RMHA Office.

Stalls will be reserved on a first come, first served basis (with payment made to RMHA) . Stalls will be checked daily for use. Storing any items (bedding, hay, buckets, etc.) in stalls will result in an additional \$60 charge per extra stall used. All stalls in use after 8:00 AM Sunday, September 10, will also result in an extra day rate charge of \$60.

Arrival: 12:00 Noon on Wednesday, September 6, 2017. Make arrangements through the RMHA office if stalls are needed prior to this time: (859) 644-5244. The daily rate for early arrival is \$60.

NOTES: Adds/Scratches must be done at least 3 classes prior to your desired class and MUST be done at the show office. Adds/Scratches cannot be taken by the Paddock Master or by the DQP. The show office MUST have a credit card number or an open check in their possession before horses can be shown. **Coupons will be used for paybacks and will expire Sept. 9.** A separate check will be written to the exhibitor or owner for paybacks. All horses are required to have current Coggins and Health Certificate (these will be checked as you enter the KHP). Persons on federal or certified HIO suspensions or disqualifications may not transport a horse to the show grounds and may not participate in the show in any way other than as a spectator. **Formal attire for Saturday evening Grand Championships is appropriate regardless of what time the class is held.**

CLASS NOTES: Pink Class (No. 500) will have a minimum \$10 donation to enter the class, more will be happily accepted. The class will be walk only, and will be judged on the best “pink” turnout, decided by our honorary judges. The entrant posting the highest donation (you may solicit from whomever you like) will also be recognized. The RMHA will donate all proceeds to a chosen charity for cancer victims. Classes 500 (Pink Class) and 81 (Costume Class) will have both adult and youth entries - NO STALLIONS ALLOWED. Class 82 and 83 will have special pricing to reflect show entry fees from 30 years ago. The class will be judged on a combination of gait and riding attire, which will be bibs and boots.

Youth and Adult Best in Blue Grand Championships (#86W)-Entrants must have received one blue ribbon in any class (excluding #500) during the 2017 Rocky Mountain International Grand Championship Show to qualify. The class will be judged on a combination of gait and rider equitation / turnout. The winner will exemplify the best qualities of a Rocky Mountain horse, the rider's horsemanship skills, and exemplary turn out.

Youth 12-17 Classes 57, 60 & 62 - To promote safety in the classes, if 12 or more riders are entered in any of these classes they will be split into two heats with the top 10 riders returning for the final placings in the class. The class will be split by riders ages, with 12-15 year olds in the first heat and 16-17 year olds in the second heat. The top five riders from each heat will return for the final class placings. If there are five or less riders in either heat, those riders will automatically move forward to the final class with the remaining number of riders needed to make a total of 10 being kept from the other heat. The top 10 riders will then compete to determine final placings for the class.
