3	Demo: Learn how to pull and attach a handle to complete the mug of your dreams! Work Time: Practice throwing/trimming, practice handles
4	Demo: Learn how to throw a bean dip bowl to bring to your next summer cookout! Work Time: Practice/make projects
5	Demo: Learn about Glazes and how to apply them to your pieces Work Time: Practice/make projects, practice glazing
6	Demo: Learn how to make a hanging planter for your mid-summer porch plants. Work Time: Wet throw focus- in class and open studio.
7	Demo: Today is the last wet clay day! No Demo. Work Time: Trim all remaining pieces & make sure they are on the shelf.
8	Demo: No demo, chat about results of learning. Work Time: Celebrate, glaze work

Be sure to follow all instructor guidance during your class, both for safety and the best throwing experience.
