Please remember this will be our social party, elections of officers and our reverse raffle. The raffle will go on during this time of the meeting and eating. If you have not purchased a raffle ticket please do so by approaching any officer or chair person. ** Please come prepared to buy at least one reverse raffle ticket** Bob Upchurch is handling the raffle with the help of Carl Bowen. Tickets can be purchased from both of them. If you buy 10 tickets you get 1 free. This is our yearly fundraiser so members please participate.

Second Chance Opportunity during the conduct of the Reverse Drawing:

If you previously purchased a \$20 Reverse Drawing ticket, then, during the event you will have the opportunity to purchase as many "Second Chance" tickets as you wish. The minutes from the Nov. 17, 2019 Thanksgiving meeting that was sent to the membership was motioned for approval by Katharine Turrone and second by PJ Barbour and passed with consensus. PJ Barbour gave the Treasurer's report. \$6,400 was collected in sponsor donations. Our expenditures were \$3,956.72. Our net profit for the event was \$2,443.28. The current checking account balance as of 2/5/2019 is \$12,046.60 and the petty cash balance remains at \$200. Including today's Valentine Social/meeting Valentines (2/9/19 our checking balance is \$11,776.38

Vice President Anne Upchurch reported information from the January 19th ACSC mtg at OD Beach and Shag Resort that she, Jesse Bradshaw and Larry Castle attended during Midwinter SOS. Currently there are 96 clubs, 15,000 members and 117 ICONS under the ACSC umbrella. Two Board members were elected. One was re-elected and David Galloway from Wilson is newly elected. The ICON Class of 2019 welcomed five new members. Larry Castle and Sylvia Anders of Atlantic Beach Shag Club joined this group in 2015 and 2010, respectively. Fun Monday Raffle ticket winners were announced. Spring Safari dates are April 26-May 5.

Jesse Bradshaw reported:

Our next Club social will be Saturday, April 20. It will be a Pre-SOS party held at Memories Beach Club.

Larry Castle has the new 2019 SOS cards. SOS cards are \$30 each.
