

## 2023 HIGHLIGHT PRESENTERS

The President, Dr. Ken Tucker, and the Dean, Dr. Mark Davis, attended and presented highlights of the UWA programs and academic programs to hosting universities and institutions in Korea and Vietnam.

UWA established a new partner relationship with SahmYook University and AKEEP, a 3-way MOU, during the International Convention on August 25, 2023. Dr. Mark Davis stressed the teacher shortage in the United States and Alabama during his UWA presentation.

Ms. Meesoon Han presented the mission and programs of AIEEP/AKEEP, especially the STEM Educators Program, which lays out pathways to convert their Foreign Teaching Certificates to Alabama's

Teaching Certificates and improve their global career opportunities.





## 2023 PRESENTERS



Mr. Erik Estill is the Executive Director and Headmaster of LEAD Academy (LEAD), the first public charter school in Montgomery County and the third public charter school in Alabama.

LEAD's mission is to provide innovative programs designed to spark curiosity, maximize learning potential, and continuously improve student achievement by empowering them with 21st-century skills. LEAD partners with AKEEP/AIEEP and supports various programs. They assist in Korean Educator Programs, including teacher internship programs, summer camp programs, and

regular academic semesters. He presented the Alabama K12 education.

During his presentation, he shared various facts about Alabama, Alabama's public education system, including student demographics and geographic perspectives, educational and financial data sources – the overall K-12 Education System, and the Shortage of STEAM field teachers in Alabama and the rest of the U.S.A.

LEAD Academy has adopted Korean as its official foreign language, while most Alabama public schools provide Spanish as their primary foreign language. They also host and sponsor the National Security Agency's K-Wave Club for all interested students beyond their students without boundaries.
