The application process for the scholarship is as follows:

- Applicants must apply for the scholarship.
- Applications must be received by October 10th at dismissal
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by October 15th

Applications must include the following:

Grades K-2

- A drawing of basketball (for those applying for basketball) or a drawing of cheer (for those applying for cheer) that shows their love for the sport, teamwork, and sportsmanship.
- Drawings must be completed by the student.
- Drawings must be completed on an 8.5x11 white copy paper sheet.
- Must include a recommendation from the child's teacher
- Must be a Colfax Elementary student
- Must try their best in the classroom
- Must demonstrate good sportsmanship
- Student's name, grade and teacher's name must be on all paperwork submitted.

Grades 3-5

- A one-page letter that explains why they love basketball/cheer and how it helps them improve teamwork and show sportsmanship
- Must include a recommendation from the child's teacher
- Must be a Colfax Elementary student
- Must try their best in the classroom
- Must demonstrate good sportsmanship
- Student's name, grade and teacher's name must be on all paperwork submitted.

Please return all applications to the office by October 10th at 2:15pm. Applications that are submitted late will not be accepted. Applications must be completed by the student only apart from the teacher recommendation letter. Recipients will be featured in the 2025-2026 yearbook. If a scholarship recipient has already paid for their basketball or cheer fees, refunds will be given to those scholarship recipients.
