INFORMATION FOR CAREGIVERS

- The first step is to scan the QR code and answer the questions. Then, a team member will contact you.
- Caregivers of eligible youth will need to sign a consent form and a summer camp waiver. This process can be completed over the phone.
- Additionally, some parents will fill out questionnaires pertaining to their child. If you are selected for this, you will have a phone interview and you will receive financial compensation.

CAMP POLICIES

- The possession or use of alcohol and other drugs, fireworks, guns and other weapons is prohibited.
- No use of tobacco products will be tolerated.
- No theft of property, regardless of owner, will be tolerated.
- Bullying, including verbal, physical and cyber bullying, is prohibited. Hazing of any kind is prohibited.
- No violence, including sexual abuse or harassment, will be tolerated.
- The parking of participant vehicles must be in accordance with University parking regulations.
- The operation of a University or personal motor vehicle by minors is prohibited during program hours.
- Misuse or damage of University facilities is prohibited. Charges will be assessed against those participants who are responsible.
- The inappropriate use of cameras, images, and digital devices is prohibited, including the use of such devices in restrooms or other areas where privacy is expected.
