The pickle ball court was approved and fencing will need to go around this court. Mr. Borck and Mr. Miller do not want to see projects done when some are not finished. Putting this kind of money into the parks will not allow much more to be done over the next 5 years. Ms. Perry asked council if McClure Tball could have an end of the year party at the park and have permission to use the water for a splash pad/sprinkler. Perry moved with Gring 2nd allowing this party, all yes motion carried.
