

Nanny's Granny Square



This is a simple pattern for a granny square that can be used for many projects. The great thing about a granny square is that you can make it any size you want and as many as you want to create a variety of projects.

Materials:

Crochet hook: Any Size Yarn: Any Type (Depending on Project)

Instructions:

Make slip knot. Chain 6. Join with sl st to form ring.

Chain 3. (This counts a 1 dc). 11 dc in ring. 12 dc. Join with sl st.

Row 1. Chain 3. Make 2 dc in between two dc. Chain 1. 3 dc in same hole. Chain 1.

*Skip 3 dc. 3 dc in between next 2 dc. Chain 1. 3 dc in same hole. Chain 1.

Repeat from * 2 more times.

Connect with slip stitch to first stitch. Square is formed.

Row 2. Chain 3. 2 dc in hole. Chain 1.

Skip 3 dc. 3 dc, chain 1, 3dc in same hole. Chain 1.

Skip 3 dc. 3 dc in hole. Chain 1.

Skip 3 dc. 3 dc, chain 1, 3dc in same hole. Chain 1.

Skip 3 dc. 3 dc in hole. Chain 1.

Skip 3 dc. 3 dc, chain 1, 3dc in same hole. Chain 1.

Skip 3 dc. 3 dc in hole. Chain 1.

Skip 3 dc. 3 dc, chain 1, 3dc in same hole. Chain 1. Join with sl st. Bind off.

To follow pattern: Remember to use 3dc on sides and 3 dc, chain 1, 3dc for the corners.

To change colors form slip knot and connect at hole where binded off. Then follow pattern from first chain 3 remembering to use 3dc on sides and 3 dc, chain 1, 3dc for the corners.
