Operations Officer L2 (IMT) ** PILOT **

- Candidates must hold the following PRE-REQUISITES
 - Group Leader (GL)
 - Conduct Briefings & Debriefings (CBD)
 - Incident Management Functions (IMF)
- Up to 20 candidates per course at Academy
- Candidates will be required to attend both weekends to complete the course.
- Candidates will also need to attend an Incident Management Assessment (IMA) Event when advised.
- **COMPETENCY AWARDED**
 - * PUAOPE023 - Manage operations for a Level 2 Incident

Logistics Officer L2 (IMT) ** PILOT **

 - Member Induction (MI)
 - Conduct Briefings & Debriefings (CBD)
 - Incident Management Functions (IMF)
- Up to 16 candidates per course at Academy
- Candidates will be required to attend both weekends to complete the course.
- All assessments are completed during the course
