Therefore, in the intense muscat aroma, you can feel elements of primary fruitiness in the form of overripe gooseberries, white peaches and honey, but also secondary aromas, which add complexity to the wine. The roundness of the wine is provided by natural grape sugar, which has been preserved after fermentation stops. You are getting a liqueur wine made using unusually reductive technologies and is therefore unusually fresh for the category of fortified wines.

The winery is located in the sub-region Velke Pavlovice | Moravia.

The current winemaker is Jan Stávek, great grandson of the founder. Jan Stávek was named Czech Winemaker of the Year 2020. Jan is only one of three winemakers in the Czech Republic licensed to make fortified wines.
