

Stavek – Frankovka Lizniperky VOC (Blaufränkisch)

Présentation de la cave VÍNO J Stávek a des racines remontant à 1898. Il a été rebaptisée au nom de l'actuel vigneron en 2013. Il est membre fondateur du VOC Modré Hora et se spécialise dans le Rosé Cuvée Frankovka et les Vins Fortifiés. Il a été élu Cave de l'Année en République Tchèque en 2017. La cave est située dans la sous-région de Velke Pavlovice | Moravie.

L'actuel vigneron est Jan Stávek, arrière-petit-fils du fondateur. Jan Stávek a été nommé Vigneron Tchèque de l'Année 2020. Jan est l'un des trois seuls vignerons en République Tchèque autorisés à produire des vins fortifiés.

The grapes for production come from an excellent vineyard track that was popular as early as the 16th century. Long long rows leading down to the south towards the town of Velké Pavlovice gave rise to excellently ripe grapes. The wine was aged in two barrels with a volume of 600 litres, which were made from oaks grown in Slavonia. The aroma features tones of black rowan and falerno. The taste is distinctly of cherry stone, vanilla and licorice. We recommend it with dark meat steaks.
