Kutna Hora Winery is Czechia's first Demeter-certified winery located in the town of Kutna Hora, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It has approximately 85 hectares under cultivation – the majority of which is used to grow grapes. The remaining fields are used to grow the herbs that are used in biodynamic farming.
