VINEYARD & VINIFICATION

Pannonian Climate, gravel, mainly sediments, sandy loam. Natural yeast, stainless steel. Aging 5 month in stainless steel

TASTING NOTES

Green yellow; muskat, elderflower, melon; these aromatics are also found on the palate combined with a vibrant, well integrated acidity and a hint of saltiness in the long finish; perfect as an aperitif or to pair with fresh cheese seasoned with herbs
