Call to order - The meeting was called to order at 3:58 pm by Debbie Harlan, President.

Introduction of guests - Ilyse Vanderah representing Havana, June Badarick Meno representing Hacienda Hills and Sally Dees representing Belle Glade.

- **Approval of the minutes from November 20, 2025, meeting.** Jan Snider requested her name be spelled correctly. Deila Treffer motioned the minutes to be approved, and Mary Hewitt seconded and approved unanimously.
- **Treasurers Report**
No changes to the report since last month. The balance is \$5480. Susan Byrne was given approval to shred old bank documents. She will keep three years of documents on file.
- **Old Business**
 - Deb Harlan will schedule a meeting with Seay Anne and Pat to discuss plans for diversifying teams, improving communication, and addressing concerns for the future. This was a result of the concerns discussed regarding the new team selection process.
 - **Debbie spoke with Seay Anne, but they did not get an opportunity to meet. They will meet next year to discuss how to improve the process and some of the fall out will be included in the strategic committee tasks.**

New Business

- **Committee Reports**
 - **Competition Committee** - Seay Anne shared there are 198 players registered. Two people registered to be in the pool and four people registered to be volunteers. Seay Anne drafted an email earlier to go out to the LGPA members. There is still misconception around the event with some people not registering as a result. Most of the new LGPA members are south of 44. We need to work harder with informing potential players that it doesn't matter where you live or which country club you play with. Five players registered today. The teams with the most need for players are Hacienda, Havana and Glenview. Most other teams have 14-15 registrants. Debbie Harlan asked for a sense of why people haven't registered. Donna Osso mentioned they have three players from last year who cannot play. Sally Dees thinks there are a few more people who will be registering for Belle Glade and Hacienda has three people ready to register.

The bottom line is we need at least 20 more people to registered. Debbie Harlan reminded us that if someone plays on any one day they are not required to pay the \$25 event fee.

Seay Anne will continue to send updates. She reminded us that no one should communicate to their players that they made the team. There seems to be confusion with the player notification process. Players are not confirmed to their team until the handicap committee has completed the compliance reviews. This should be accomplished by January 18, 2025, may be earlier. It was also noted that recruiting can still take place. Seay Anne will provide the number of people who are willing to play for other teams. Debbie Harlan reiterated that it is incumbent of all of us to make sure people understand the new process and to encourage registration. We should not be telling players they are not going to make a team.

Connie asked if the registration form had a question asking if this was the first time a player registered. It does not but will be considered for the next event.

Seay Anne mentioned the meeting room has been confirmed for the draft if it is necessary. The date will be January 23 from 4-6 pm at Sea Breezie in the Lake Meona room. She also mentioned that everyone should be alert for any potential emails the first week in January that may need discussion prior to the January 15th meeting.

The competition committee is working on completing the conditions of competition. The next major section is Pace of Play. Peggy Pruitt has drafted a document that the committee needs to review.

Debbie Harlan mentioned The Villages Event calendar has been corrected. She also asked the captains to make sure the flyer is still on display.

- **Communications Committee**
 - Committee Position Descriptions - Pat Golen distributed the position descriptions with the changes that were provided. Each section was review and a final version will be provided at the January 15th meeting.
 - Debbie is going to have the committee position description finalized at the January 15th meeting.
 - Pat Golen will begin the description descriptions for the following committees: Logistic and Strategic and provide a draft at the February meeting.
 - Pat Golen will prepare a player description at the February meeting.
 - Pat will present the existing captain and co-captain descriptions for review at the January meeting.
 - For the January meeting we will discuss the “On Course Captain for the day” description.
 - Debbie Harlan will organize the Google Drive and write a formal procedure. **We need a date.**

- **Pro-am Committee** - Mary Hewitt will schedule a meeting with Linda Oakman to learn the process. The event will be held at Havana.
- **Tee Gift Committee** - Paula Boulette will order the tee gifts December 19, 2025. A decision on the gift for volunteer will be added to the January agenda. It was noted there were 20 volunteers in 2025.

- **Raffles Committee/Charities** - Ilyse Vanderah shared that Cindy Globush confirmed she is ready for the raffles at the Pro-am and Tee-Off party.
- **Tee-Off Party Committee** - Jan Snider informed everyone the Tee-Off party date had to change due to the Championship event. The new date is Sunday, March 29. Set up time is 4:30 pm and the party is 5-7pm. Jan mentioned that Suzie provided her with some rule questions to include in their presentation. If anyone else had suggestions, please forward to Jan. Debbie Harlan mentioned that she is having a meeting with the rules official and Jan will be invited. A suggestion to have local rules / stakes colors per course would be beneficial
- **Logistics Committee** - Carol Smith mentioned she spoke with Jenn Hibbard who will speak to the pro at Havana and possibly cord off an area for parking. The other suggestion was for people to park their vehicles at Colony and share a ride to Havana.
- **Strategic Committee** - Nothing to report.
- **Budget** - Nothing to report - it was approved last month.
