HOWLER EXTRA!

The January issue of the Howler promised an opportunity to discuss the tactics and the objectives of the Humane Society of the United States as well as the possibility of making some headway in the conflict over the rights of dog owners and citizens. The HSUS is not your friend, it is not your dog's friend. The organization has virtually unlimited funds and a large membership including many influential people. Short of throwing up our hands and falling on our swords in the town square what are we to do?

Help is on the way. Let me have the ADOA introduce you to the cavalry. ***"The grassroots initiative I stumbled upon, headed up by attorney, former 20-year Wash D.C. lobbyist, and Air Force Judge Advocate, Frank Losey, is nothing short of brilliant. Although Frank lost his beloved pet years ago, (no replacement yet), he understands fully what we are facing with the animal rights movement, because of working with lobbyists from other states. He knows the HSUS lies, their scams, their wealth. However, there is a way the "little guy" can win against this giant, and that is by having three things: FACTS, FORTITUDE and FIGHTERS. Frank is giving us the facts; we have to provide the rest."***

Frank Losey's strategy is simple, elegant and economical. Here is a short briefing on how it will work. HSUS is an IRS section 501(c)(3) organization, in other words a charity. HSUS is also a lobbying organization. Lobbying is illegal for a section 501(c)(3) organization. Frank Losey's strategy is a mass mailing campaign to alert the IRS to HSUS's illegal activity and force an investigation of HSUS's abuse of its status.

Our part is to send a one page letter similar to the one on the next page to the IRS.

- 1. Ideally, send the letter by certified mail - - you do not need to ask for a return signature receipt.**
- 2. If you send your letter by certified mail, I would appreciate if you would send me (Frank Losey) the receipt or a copy of the green and white certified mail receipt either by E-Mail or the United States Postal Service.**
- 3. If you can't scan or copy the receipt, just send me the 20 digit tracking number on the left side of the certified mail receipt and I can download confirmation of delivery. (Copies of the certified mail receipts and tracking number confirmations will enhance the planned follow-up actions in Washington DC.)**

Even if you don't send a letter by certified mail, send a letter regular first class mail, just email me when you have done so. Its not as good because it doesn't afford me with evidence, but still better than nothing. Please encourage your friends to do the same.

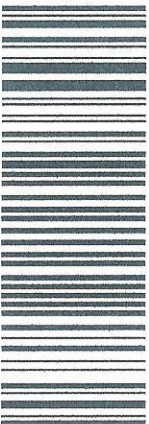
