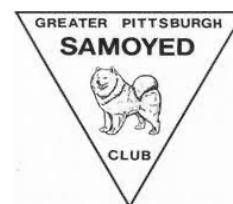

Awards

An orange ribbon will be awarded to each dog that receives a qualification towards a coursing ability title. An orange rosette will be substituted for dogs that have finished a new title.

Eligibility for Coursing Ability Tests

Are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Services (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigree are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
- Dogs that are not present at the ending time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period and no refund will be given.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entries will be refunded.
- There will be a minimum \$25 returned check charge.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any handler not cleaning up after their dog.
- Battery or gas powered; continuous loop equipment will be used.
- Lures consist of white plastic.
- Greater Pittsburgh Samoyed Club and Tri-State Sighthound Club reserves the right to alter course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the test.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds by the Test Committee.
- Children **MUST** be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.
- Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judge, and Handler of the dog running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.
- At the discretion of Tri-State Sighthound Club, we may break periodically during the day to accommodate judge and worker ring times and lunch

ROLL CALL AND INSPECTION

All dogs must be presented for inspection without tape, bandages, wrapping, or covered of any kind (e.g., coats and blankets). At least two persons from the Test Committee will inspect each entered dog for lameness, fitness to compete, and female estrus (in season). In their opinion, any entered dogs that is found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season will not be allowed to run. Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are old, have breathing or heart problems, are overweight, or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The entry fee will be refunded for any dog that is not allowed to run by the inspectors.

Roll call and inspection will run continuously for the period listed. Bring your dog at any time during that time period. Any dog that fails to present for inspection prior to the close of roll call and inspection will be marked absent. No refund will be given for an absent dog.

HOW TO ENTER

Complete an official AKC entry form (see subsequent pages of the premium list or got to http://images.akc.org/pdf/LureCoursing_Entry.pdf) for each dog for each test, and either mail your entries and entry fee to the Event Secretary (see address on page 2 of the premium list) or turn your entries in at the Event Secretary's desk on the field before the close of entries. Be sure to include the entry fee. Each dog may only enter once per test. **Enter early, as only 150 entries will be accepted for each test. Make checks payable to TSSC. Or enter ONLINE at:**

Any dog can be registered with the AKC. If your dog needs to be registered, you can do so on-line at http://www.akc.org/canine_partners/ or by completing the Canine Partner Enrollment Application. If the latter, submit the enrollment application, along with the enrollment fees, at the time of entry to the Event Secretary. Note that Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered.

You may also early enter by mailing all of the forms and fees to the Event Secretary, so that it is received by the closing date and time for early entries. If your dog becomes lame, sick, or in season prior to the test, do not bring them to the test. Instead, contact the Event Secretary to cancel your entry, and your entry fee will be destroyed or otherwise refunded. **Entering early is advised, as each test is limited to 150 entries.**

Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form. Follow your veterinarian's recommendations to assure that your dogs are free of parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

The Event Secretary must have the completed entry form and payment before a dog may be presented for inspection.

PADDOCK

We will begin running courses as soon as roll call an inspection begin. When you are ready to run your dog, bring them to the paddock, the assembly area for dogs that have passed inspection and are prepared to run. Dogs may run wearing a close-fitting buckle collar, choke collars and collars with dangling decorations will not be allowed. Hanging collars tags may be permitted if they are secured tight to the collar, such as by tape. Slip leads can be used if the owner desires.

PADDOCK (continued)

The Paddock Master determines the order in which dogs run. After passing inspection, you must check in with the Paddock Master to ensure that your dog has been placed in the running order. If you must leave the area to pursue another activity, please inform the Paddock Master and then be sure to check in with the Paddock Master again when you return. In general, the Paddock Master will identify the next available dog based on the order in which they checked in to the pattern. If the previous course was run only on the first half of the total course length, the Paddock Master may select the next available dog that can be tested on the second half. If a dog is not present when it's called to run its test, the dog's name will be moved to the end of the running order. After roll call inspection closes, any entered dog that has not yet tested and is not present within 5 minutes of completion of the last course will be marked absent and no refund will be given.

RUNNING THE COURSE

Each dog runs by itself and only one time in each testing event. They chase lures made of plastic strips that by, by string and pulleys, follow a course in a field.

Any enter dog that is less than 12 inches tall at the withers or Brachcephalic (i.e. "flat faced", such as a bulldog - see chart at end of premium list) will run a clearly marked 300 yard course, which must be completed in 90 seconds. Any entered dog that is more than 12 inches tall at the withers and not brachcephalic will run a clearly marked 600-yard course, which must be completed in 120 seconds. If there is a question as to which course a dog should run, the judge will decide. *If your dog is 7 years of age or older, you may declare your dog a veteran prior to the start of the course. Your dog will be allowed to run 2/3 of the normal distance.*

The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and, therefore, is in complete charge of the dog and handler on the field. In service to this responsibility, the Huntmaster has the authority to stop the lure at any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve their dog. The handler should retrieve their dog promptly at the end of the course. Listen to the huntmaster and follow their instructions promptly and swiftly.

The coursing ability test parentheses CAT and parentheses is a pass slash fail test period in order to pass the dogmas chase the plastic lure and complete the course one time, by itself and, with enthusiasm and without interruption, within the allotted time.

Field Set Up

- ◆ Come early one hour before roll call and start by carrying equipment
- ◆ Learn as you go how to place pulleys and tie downs.

Field Clerk

- ◆ Volunteer to help the field clerk
- ◆ Learn how results are recorded
- ◆ The benefit is you will get a new perspective on the course

Runner

- ◆ Volunteer to run paperwork from the field clerk to the field trial secretary

Lure Operator

- ◆ Hang around and talk to the lure operator between courses
- ◆ If you are interested, try running the lure around before the trial, at lunch or after the trial.

Frequently Asked Questions

- What time is roll call?
Roll call begins at 8:30 and ends at 2:00. It's a rolling roll call so you can check in at any time during that time period. Once your dog has passed inspection its name will be added to the run list and we will follow that as closely as we can. Since the CAT is held in conjunction with a show and other events, we understand you may have to leave and come back. That's OK. Your dog will hold its position on the run list.
- Will I receive a schedule for the time my dog runs?
No. As stated above your dog's name will be added to the run list once it has completed roll call and inspection. This gives flexibility to those that are participating in other events that day.
- Will you be taking entries the day of the event?
Yes. If you plan to enter the day of the event, it will make it much easier for you and us to fill out entry form(s) at home and bring them with you paying when you get there. We accept cash or check. Checks should be made out to TSSC.
- Are there two events each day?
No. Because this CAT is held in conjunction with a show and other events we like to give participants the flexibility and ease to participate in the CAT.
