Report of the President

- o AKC sent an email stating that they are seeing live events returning to pre-pandemic levels, entries are up at shows being held, consistent with where we were before. If we see limited entry shows, don't panic. Madison shows haven't filled yet. Not too many places setting limits lower than what have seen in the past.
- o Second annual AKC Premier Cup was held at the Equestrian Center in California. Primarily for agility dogs, competed in jump heights. \$10k awarded between 5 winners. The good thing about this is dog sports are getting more publicity, aired on ESPN. Got good reviews, AKC is very proud of the dogs, exhibitors, and staff.
- o AKC Meet the Breeds Extravaganza is on a National tour, with events in San Diego CA and Dallas Texas. Hosting booths with 100 different dog breeds, depicting specific about the dogs. Doing in conjunction with local club participation for various breeds.
- o AKC endorsing Healthy Dog Importation Act of 2021. If you are into being politically active for dogs, you can contact the House of Representatives. Encourage them to support the measure.
- o Bans placed recently on import of dogs, believe dogs imported without going through all proper health checks have come in with rabies.

Report of the Secretary

- o Received several AKC Government Relations emails.
 - As Marty mentioned, one of which announced that the CDC is temporarily suspending the importation of dogs from countries classified as high risk for rabies
 - Quite a list of countries, from areas such as Africa, Caribbean, Asia, Middle East, and Eastern Europe.
 - Looks to be limited, Advanced written approval available on a case by case basis
- o Another one is in regards to recently passed PA House legislation regarding the exemption of Dog Law fines and fees from being deposited into the Judicial Computer System Augmentation account
 - Currently, the Bureau of Dog Law Enforcement has been operating at a deficit
 - This legislation would help address this issue by exempting fines, court fees and costs under the Dog Law from being transferred to the Judicial Augmentation Account.
 - This could be an extra \$200k per year that is current lost revenue for the Bureau of Dog Law Enforcement
 - Bill has been assigned to the Senate Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee.
 - The email has instructions for those interested in commenting on the House Bill, and how you can do so by contacting members of the Committee or your Senator
