- o Vendors - did get one, from food truck fair in Seven Fields. Penn Town Dogs - hot dogs, hamburgers, typical fair food
- o Haven't heard back from deep fried veggie girl from memorial show, haven't gotten contract back yet
- o General vendor, Be your own dog, Mr Waggs coming.
- o Sharpening guy, local dog food person from Cranberry, who also at Memorial Day shows. All natural treats and lines of dog foods
- o Also the girl who does beaded leads and embroidery
- o Jean found info for t-shirt vendor, need to contact them to see if they still have our artwork on file, what price is, etc.

 - Nominations cannot be made at the annual meeting (October)
 - Slate will be as proposed next month, as no one put in any other names for a position.
 - Only change will be one of the Directors
- AKC Website/Club Info
 - It was noted last month that some of the club info out on the AKC site for our club is incorrect
 - Jean's address has been corrected, and Reba's name in the detail section has been replaced with mine.
 - AKC will send a form for the upcoming election, that we then mark any updates/leave the same if not changing.
 - There are three different ways to update the site, two different logins, and one area you just fill out the form and email it to them.

New Business

- AKC Delegate Information
 - Dave stated that Delegates have their own login area on the AKC site.
 - We can ask Barb to tell us what's going on with AKC-Google.com, that is the Delegates own chat area, sometimes they have specific discussions of interest.
 - Currently there is an argument going on regarding what criteria is used to hire field reps.
 - Reps are getting to shows, but not equally to Performance Events. AKC does not care about performance as much. Just send your money. 3 field reps for all of the United States.
 - For shows cover 95% of dog shows. Some of this is due to the number of people entering Shows versus Performance Events, and there are so many different Performance Events.
 - AKC did just hire a new AKC Field Rep for Conformation.
 - We also cannot tell what they get paid either.
 - Delegates getting upset as this information is not getting through to them
 - If you have questions for Barb to take to the AKC meetings, send them on for her
 - There are 11 standing committees. If you get elected to a standing committee, then they will pay you a small amount of money to go (\$200, which of course does not cover much). But otherwise you pay all your own expenses.
 - Also if on a committee, then you have to stay another day, for extra meetings, so more hotel costs, etc.
 - You can be a delegate for another club who doesn't have a rep if you are interested.
