The Water-to-Water (Trip on the Hydrogen Highway) is now less than 2 months away. Planning for the trip is (with occasional hiccups) going along smoothly.

Because there are no mobile hydrogen fuelers currently approvable, we will be using a deluxe <u>autotransporter</u> to traverse the "hydrogen deserts" on our way north. A trip <u>banner/wrap</u> will be placed on each side of the transporter to promote the trip and transportation-hydrogen. The transporter can carry a maximum of six FCEVs. We currently have six cars/drivers signed up for the trip (if you would like to be added to a waiting list, please let me know).

While we are limited to six cars heading north to British Columbia, <u>all hydrogen cars</u> can join us on the first leg of the trip, from the Golden Gate Bridge to the Capitol building in Sacramento on Friday, Sept. 12. We will start the trip at 9 in the morning next to the beautiful <u>Horseshoe Bay</u>, just north of the bridge. From there we will proceed to the afternoon rally adjacent to the Capitol steps where we will hear first-hand updates from H_2 leaders in industry, government and academia, and enjoy food, door prizes and the camaraderie of fellow FCEV owners.
