[returning back to our Father in Heaven, becoming "one" with Christ and Father as recorded in John 17] And you will recognize your neighbor has the same potential. I don't identify with all the LDS beliefs but with the "truth" I have discovered that is in and through alli]. I am married to my sweetheart, [my one and only] now moving into our 50th blessed year. We don't agree in everything, if fact we have disagreements but we both know that we each have the divine, innate potential to become as Christ is and as Father is [Matt 5: 43-48 and John 17]. There are several beliefs or doctrines in the LDS Church I do not believe in, and they did not start with the Prophet Joseph Smith. I know the LDS Church has and still does a lot of good in my life and I have been blessed because of it and am fully aware to this day, that the LDS Church is under condemnation iii because it is still holding on to the false doctrine and belief of polygamy; when the Prophet Joseph taught and lived differently [D&C 42:22-26] and D&C 49: 15-17]. - 31 Without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful:
- 32 Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. (New Testament | Romans 1:24 32)
- ii "For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.

I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth." [New Testament | 3 John 1:3-4]

- iii Behold, I am Alpha and Omega, even Jesus Christ.
- 61 Wherefore, let all men beware how they take my name in their lips—
- 62 For behold, verily I say, that many there be who are under this condemnation, who use the name of the Lord, and use it in vain, *having not authority*.
- 63 *Wherefore, let the church repent of their sins*, and I, the Lord, will own them; otherwise they shall be cut off.
- 64 Remember that that which cometh from above is sacred, and must be spoken with care, and by constraint of the Spirit; and in this there is no condemnation, and ye receive the Spirit through prayer; wherefore, without this there remaineth condemnation. (Doctrine and Covenants | Section 63:60 64)
- "For whoso cometh not unto me is under the bondage of sin.
- 52 And whoso receiveth not my voice is not acquainted with my voice, and is not of me.
- 53 And by this you may know the righteous from the wicked, and that the whole world groaneth under sin and darkness even now.
- 54 And your minds in times past have been darkened because of unbelief, and because you have treated lightly the things you have received—
- 55 Which vanity and unbelief have brought the whole church under condemnation.
- 56 And this condemnation resteth upon the children of Zion, even all.
- 57 And they shall remain under this condemnation until they repent and [1] remember the new covenant, [2] even the Book of Mormon and [3] the former commandments which I have given them, not only to say, but to do according to that which I have written—
- 58 That they may bring forth fruit meet for their Father's kingdom; otherwise there remaineth a scourge and judgment to be poured out upon the children of Zion.

59 For shall the children of the kingdom pollute my holy land? Verily, I say unto you, Nay."

(Doctrine and Covenants | Section 84:51 - 59)

the glory which the Father and the Son have, is because they are just and holy beings; and that if they were lacking in one attribute or perfection which they have, the glory which they have, never could be enjoyed by them; for it requires them to be precisely what they are in order to enjoy it: and if the Savior gives this glory to any others, he must do it in the very way set forth in his prayer to his Father: by making them one with him, as he and the Father are one.—In so doing he would give them the glory which the Father has given him; and when his disciples are made one with the Father and the Son, as the Father and the Son are one, who cannot see the propriety of the Savior's saying, The works which I do, shall they do; and greater works than these shall they do, be cause I go to the Father?

16 "These teachings of the Savior must clearly show unto us the nature of salvation; and what he proposed unto the human family when he proposed to save them—That he proposed to make them like unto himself; and he was like the Father, the great prototype of all saved beings: And for any portion of the human family to be assimilated into their likeness is to be saved; and to be unlike them is to be destroyed: and on this hinge turns the door of salvation.

17 "Who cannot see, then, that salvation is the effect of faith? for as we have previously observed, *all the heavenly beings work by this principle*; and it is because they are able so to do that they are saved: *for nothing but this could save them.* [Lectures of Faith 7:15-17].
