Path of Repentance for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints

"NOW the word of the LORD came unto Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me." (Old Testament | Jonah 1:1 - 2). And they repented and were spared the destruction.

Why am I using this metaphor for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints? Because it fits perfectly if the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Church repents.

Warning: "And they (Latter-day Church) shall remain under this condemnation until they repent and remember the new covenant, even the Book of Mormon and the former commandments which I have given them, not only to say, but to do according to that which I have written" (Revelation given September 1832, Doctrine and Covenants | Section 84:57). Polygamy was already being introduced into the church in direct violation to D&C 42:22-26 and D&C 49:15-17.

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, (Latter-Day Church) darkness covereth the earth, and gross darkness the minds of the people, and *all flesh has become corrupt before my face*. [How do we become wicked or corrupt? By lies and continuing to perpetuate the lie that the Prophet Joseph Smith lived and taught polygamy when he did no such thing].

- 24 Behold, vengeance cometh speedily upon the inhabitants of the earth, a day of wrath, a day of burning, a day of desolation, of weeping, of mourning, and of lamentation; and as a whirlwind it shall come upon all the face of the earth, saith the Lord.
- 25 And upon my house shall it begin [Latter-day Church], and from my house shall it go forth, saith the Lord;

26 First among those among you, [Latter-day Church] saith the Lord, who have professed to know my name [If we truly follow the God of truth, who does not lie, why would we choose to perpetuate a lie?] and have not known me, and have blasphemed against me in the midst of my house, saith the Lord." (Doctrine and Covenants | Section 112:23 - 26) Revelation given July 23, 1837

What is the wickedness the Latter-day Church needs to repent of? I will paraphrase them here: Again, it all begins with a lie.

- 1. Stop *perpetuating the lies and deceit* that the Prophet Joseph Smith introduced and lived polygamy when he never did. Remove all accusations of this lie and deceit on the lds.org website.
- 2. **Remove D&C 132 from our scriptures, it is also a lie** and restore D&C 101 of 1835. D&C 101 of 1835 was canonized as scripture through "common consent" in the Church. The current D&C 132 was never put in by "common consent" of the Church because it was and is a false doctrine Brigham Young created to validate his adulterous lifestyle through his lies, deceit, and adultery, violating D&C 42:22-26 and D&C 49:15-17 and Jacob 1-3.
- 3. Bring back D&C 1844 Doctrine and Covenants which would include "Lectures on Faith," as the "Doctrine of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints as it was in Joseph's Day.
- 4. Restore the word "fathers" back into Jacob 3:5 as it was when the Prophet Joseph was alive.

"Behold, the Lamanites your brethren, whom ye hate because of their filthiness and the cursing which hath come upon their skins, are more righteous than you; for they have not forgotten the commandment of the Lord, which was given unto our father *(it should say fathers)*—that they should have save it were one wife, and concubines they should have none, and there should not be whoredoms committed among them. And now, this commandment they observe to keep; wherefore, because of this observance,

in keeping this commandment, the Lord God will not destroy them, but will be merciful unto them; and one day they shall become a blessed people."

(Book of Mormon | Jacob3:5 - 6)

In the first Book of Mormon, it said "fathers" and did so from 1830 – 1920.

The original Book of Mormon printings of Jacob 3:5 said "fathers" and was changed to "father" in the 1981 printing and so it has been forwarded on to us falsely, as another lie] Who had the "right" to change the word "fathers" to father, and to do it without the "common consent" of the church?

"Fathers" is how it should read...because "the commandment" to have only "one wife" was a commandment going all the way back to all the "fathers" (Adam onward were to obey this commandment, no exceptions).

5. Remove the practice of "Marriage" being performed inside the temple to the outside of the temple in a public setting, as it was when Joseph was alive.

Our current temple endowment is wrong. Brigham Young introduced it to support his polygamy and his false claim to the "sealing powers of Elijah". Read D&C 101 of 1835 or D&C 109 of 1844.

This was canonized scripture in the Prophet Joseph Smiths Day, and it said:

"1. According to the customs of all civilized nations, marriage is regulated by laws and ceremonies: therefore we believe that *all marriages in this church of Christ of Latter Day Saints, should be solemnized in a public meeting*, or feast, prepared for that purpose" [D&C 101:1 of 1835 or D&C 109:1 of 1844].

Brigham Young wanted to justify his adultery through polygamy by doctoring the History of the LDS Church [listen to footnote i]. Not only did he create D&C 132, a false doctrine, he claimed that Joseph Smith was the author, which was an outright lie, he also doctored D&C 110, a vision that took place in the Kirtland Temple that put forth another lie; that Elijah had come and committed the "keys" to Joseph with the sealing powers. Brigham Young had no clue what the meaning of "turning the hearts of the fathers to the children and the hearts of the children to the fathers" ment. The Latter-Day Church today doesn't understand it either because of its indoctrination into polygamy, and marriage sealings, being performed in the temples. *Christ taught* that there is "no marriage or given in marriage after the resurrection," " so what would be the purpose of marriage sealings for eternity in the temple if procreation is only for mortality? You see, Brigham and those who were led astray into polygamy thought that the "marriage sealing" would give them the right to have "spirit children" in the Celestial Glory. They did not understand the scriptures or what Christ taught, that there is "no marriage or given in marriage after the **resurrection,**" no procreation! That's right, procreation is "only" a mortal experience, a mortal commandment. "Mariage sealings" therefore has nothing to do with a "temple" of brick and mortar, but everything to do with who we really are individually, we are the temple of the living God! And how are we "sealed" to God [Father and Christ] only by spiritually becoming like them in Chairty, the pure love of Christ, in Honesty, and in Virtue [moral integrity]. Brigham and those who followed him into polygamy and those who are promoting the lie of D&C 132 today is why the condemnation is upon the Latter-Day Church.

What do the scriptures teach us? Christ is the groom, and the Latter-Day Church should be the bride, iii the symbolism is clear and exact. So, before the Lord comes in glory, we should make ourselves ready to be the righteous bride of Christ, even the 5 wise virgins. Marriage is an icon of a greater spiritual reality and points to the relationship between Christ and His Church or more explicitly Christ and our individual relationship with Him, in becoming like Him. This refers to the "heart" and character of God: "And the LORD thy God will circumcise thine heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live" (Old Testament | Deuteronomy 30:6). "Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD" (Old Testament | 1 Chronicles 16:10). This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them (New Testament | Hebrews 10:16).

"Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:

6 And he shall turn the *heart* of the fathers to the children, and the *heart* of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse." (Old Testament | Malachi 4:5 - 6).

The whole idea of turning our "hearts" to our fathers, is to do it in righteousness, without lies and deceptions, without polygamy, adultery and LGTB lifestyles. The "heart" has everything to do with Lectures on Faith 7: 15-17. The "heart" is the spiritual symbol of divine nature, of godliness, being "born again" or "born of God" in holiness of character. This is the true "spirit of Elijah" and it is here now and has been a part of every generation since Adam and Eve and will continue until the Lord comes to us individually and in glory to the world who have prepared their "hearts" for Him.

"That the glory which the Father and the Son have, is because they are just and holy beings; and that if they were lacking in one attribute or perfection which they have, the glory which they have, never could be enjoyed by them; for it requires them to be precisely what they are in order to enjoy it..."

"...the Savior must clearly show unto us the nature of salvation; [meaning Celestial Glory] and what he proposed unto the human family when he proposed to save them—That he proposed to make them like unto himself; and he was like the Father, the great prototype of all saved beings: *And for any portion of the human family to be assimilated into their likeness is to be saved*; and to be unlike them is to be destroyed: and on this hinge turns the door of salvation.

17 'Who cannot see, then, that salvation is the effect of faith?" [Lecture on Faith 7: 15-17].

This is how we are sealed together as an individual, a family, a church, and as a people of our Father, by our "hearts" [minds and hearts] being immersed and baptized into the attributes of godliness as the Father and Christ are. Only "On this hinge turns the door of salvation." It is a spiritual door within us that brings us into the holy of holies where we will see Father and Christ face to face with our own body temple. iv. Doing baptisms for the dead with endless genealogies is

"dead works" vi and won't save a single soul in Celestial Glory. The work for the living and the dead is a spiritual work, it is innate to all, it is everyone's birthright and inheritance. Both the living, and the dead are accountable themselves for being "born again" or "born of God," having no desire to sin [lie or believe in the false doctrine of polygamy] but to do good continually! This is the welding link that binds and seals us with Christ and Father.

This is what the temple endowment would look like to me if the Prophet Joseph were here today. He would say: "You are the only true temple of the living God, made without hands."

"And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

13 And said unto them, It is written, *My house shall be called the house of prayer*; but ye have made it a den of thieves. (New Testament | Matthew 21:12 - 13).

There will be only two temples of brick and mortar on the earth during the millennium; one will be in Jerusalem and one in Jackson County Missouri. Moneychangers [tithing] would never be a requisite for temple worship. At 12 years of age Christ was found in the temple teaching. Christ set the example. It would be a temple of prayer, a house of prayer and the message taught in that temple would be Lectures on Faith, the Doctrine of Christ, instructing us how to become like him in character and attribute! This would be the essence of message of the endowment, that "I AM the Temple of the living God made without hands" preparing myself to meet Him face to face before the Second Coming of Christ. vii

"FOR we know that if our earthly house of *this* tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an *house NOT made with hands*, eternal in the heavens." (New Testament | 2 Corinthians 5:1).

"But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, NOT made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;" (New Testament | Hebrews 9:11).

This is the endowment that I believe the Prophet Joseph was trying to teach the people, but they hardened their hearts and wanted a temple of brick and mortal "made with hands." So, they murdered the prophet and followed Brigham into polygamy, immoral thinking. If the Latter-Day Church does not repent, what do you think the outcome will be? If we liken the scriptures unto ourselves, we will have the same fate the Jews had when they lost both temples in Jerusalem and for this same reason the Latter-Day Church today, with its "many" temples "made with hands," will lose their temples because we have embraced the lie, we are propagating that lie and falling into idolatry and formalism in our worship.

"And I will destroy your high places, and cut down your images, And I will make your cities waste, and bring your sanctuaries unto desolation, And I will bring the land into desolation: and your enemies which dwell therein shall be astonished at it." (Old Testament | Leviticus 26:30 - 32).

Brigham Young had the History of the LDS Church doctored, changed to fit his adulterous lifestyle of polygamy and the LDS Church today has bought into it.

- "Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, *rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do*. Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and *of* a good conscience, and *of* faith unfeigned" (New Testament | 1 Timothy 1:4 5).
- vi How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from *dead works* to serve the living God? (New Testament | Hebrews 9:14)
- "BEHOLD, I say unto you that all old covenants have I caused to be done away in this thing; and this is a new and an everlasting covenant, even that which was from the beginning.
- 2 Wherefore, although a man should be baptized an hundred times it availeth him nothing, for you cannot enter in at the strait gate by the law of Moses, neither by your dead works. [Why? Because real baptism is when we immerse our mind and heart into the attributes and character of godliness and become the true temple

of the living God. This is my birthright and inheritance and yours too if you accept it!

- 3 For it is because of your *dead works* that I have caused this last covenant and this church to be built up unto me, even as in days of old.
- 4 Wherefore, enter ye in at the gate, as I have commanded, and seek not to counsel your God. Amen. (Doctrine and Covenants | Section 22:1 4).
- vii Let us here observe, that after any portion of the human family are made acquainted with the important fact that there is a God who has created and does uphold all things, the extent of their knowledge, respecting his character and glory, will depend upon their diligence and faithfulness in seeking after him, until like Enoch the brother of Jared, and Moses, they shall obtain faith in God, and power with him to behold him face to face." [Lectures on Faith 2:55].

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
