

(Figure 1) The “Spirit of Truth” or Circle of Truth

This circle represents you! It represents the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. It represents the *potential* of all people of all races and religions. There is not a person or individual that is not represented by this circle. The line down the middle of the circle represents your agency or choice. Each of us is responsible for the “attributes” we create. Therefore which “side” of the circle we build upon is the character and “kingdom” we are creating for ourselves. When it comes to our greatest *potential*, it matters not what DNA, race, culture, religion, or heritage we come from,ⁱ for the ultimate decision of *character and beliefs and destiny* is based on what we choose to *personify within!* We are and always have been a “Spirit of Truth”ⁱⁱ with the choice to manifest the “Unconditional Attributes & beliefs of Freedom” or the “Conditional Attributes & beliefs of Bondage!”



The “Unconditional Attributes of Freedom” is the path to a *“fullness of truth,”* of holiness,ⁱⁱⁱ atonement, harmony, peace, miracles, healings, and the first resurrection! All will eventually embrace either the *“fullness of Truth”* or a *“portion of the Truth.”* Accepting *the beliefs* that reflect the “unconditional attributes of freedom” is to experience a *“Fullness of Truth;”* which “is knowledge of things as they are, and as they were, and as they are to come^{iv}” from God’s perspective^v! Any belief system which embraces any of the “conditional attributes of bondage” or “conditional thinking” becomes the veil that separates one from becoming as “God” is.

Test these “Attributes of Freedom” and discover *the beliefs* that embrace them and see where it takes you! You will be enlightened and awakened beyond measure as you come to understand the *potential* you really have and all that you are connected to via the “*Truth*” that is manifest in and through all things. The *key* to interpreting “conditions,” laws, or commandments from God is to view it symbolically and not absolutely; spiritually and not temporally^{vi} so that our thoughts and intents embrace the “Spirit of the Law;” the “Unconditional Law” and all the “Attributes of Freedom” without judgment, anger or blame.^{vii}

“Religion:” its laws, ordinances, ceremonies, and commandments are here because mankind as a whole has fallen from the grace (or character) of God and is not seeking to understand or live up to his greatest potential of personifying a godly character/attributes in all the experiences of life. Nor does man seek to understand how his attributes and character affect the whole process of creation. “Religion” therefore is a test for all mankind... to see if he will seek, find and embrace “again” the attributes, character, and perfections of godliness and holiness and *personify* and *manifest* those qualities in all he/she does in: religion, work, play and all endeavors without “judgment of others” gossip or blame. Man’s greatest obstacle in fulfilling his greatest potential is himself, his own fallen and carnal nature. Jesus Christ said:

1 JUDGE not, that ye be not judged.

2 For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

3 And why beholdest thou the mote (a “mote” is an external symbol of a religious structure or external traditions of a culture and/or politics that man uses to judge or blame others by) that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam (a “beam” is another external symbol of a religious structure or external traditions of a culture and/or politics that man uses to judge or blame others by) that is in thine own eye?

4 Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, let me pull out the mote out of thine eye; and, behold, a beam is in thine own eye?

5 Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye. (In both cases the “mote of judgment” and the “beam of judgment” must be cast out in order that unconditional clarity of “heart” and “mind” can awaken in us and be manifest in us).^{viii}

“Judgment” is always connected to “structures” or “forms” and has ruined more relationships, individuals, families, homes, tribes, cultures, businesses, governments, religions, nations, countries, races, friendships with broken hearts, despair, lies, greed, separation, lust, war, anger, worry, blame, gossip, stress, and hate than any other characteristic or attribute of the human character! It is poison to the soul! It damns any individual who embraces this bondage! The only way to get rid of it is to not use it☺ ...it is that simple! Change you’re thinking to “unconditional thinking,” unconditional love, and unconditional honesty and you will change your life forever!^{ix}
