Texas Mini Milkers Hill Country Two-Step Show Rules

1. Entry fees are non-refundable. Entry fees are per goat per ring. TMM Members are \$10 per goat per ring and \$15 for non-members. Entries are to be completed and paid for on the Showman App. To become a TMM member, visit our [website](#). If you select member prices on the Showman App and you are not a member, you will be invoiced for the \$25 member fee.
2. a) Standard Dairy Goats: This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and **ADGA rules shall govern**. Junior Doe and Combined Doe shows are separately sanctioned.
b) Mini Dairy Goats: This show is sanctioned by the Miniature Dairy Goat Association, and **MDGA show rules shall govern**. Junior Doe and Combined Doe shows are separately sanctioned.
3. Arrival and check-in will begin Saturday, May 2nd, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. All juniors should be checked in by 3:00 p.m. on Saturday. For Sunday arrivals, Combined Doe check-in will occur Sunday morning from 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. All Combined Does competing on Sunday should be checked in by 7:30 a.m.
4. The base date for calculating age is the day of the show (Junior – May 2 & Combined – May 3).
5. There is no pre-show milk-out. Please be sure your does are shown with a comfortable amount of milk in their udders.
6. Exhibitors should dress appropriately. A white shirt and white pants or skirt are preferred, but a black or dark blue pair of pants is acceptable.
7. We will have shavings from Tractor Supply Company available at the show for \$10 a bag – pre-order in Showman. A Pizza Dinner on Saturday evening will be available to pre-purchase—see the Showman App for details.
8. Campfires, glass containers, and fireworks are not permitted at KCYAEC. All milk needs to be dumped in the restroom sinks or toilets. No smoking. Dogs must always be on a leash, and they are not allowed in the goat pen area.
9. Please come prepared with tie chains, especially if you are showing in more than one class. We will have volunteers to help show but they may not always be available to help you. Ask for help when checking in if you will need help showing.
10. In addition, please keep ALL first and second-place animals ringside so that we may quickly get them in the lineup for Grand and Reserve Champion. All first-place animals will line up when it is called, with all second-place animals directly behind those places.
11. Health papers are not required, but animals showing signs of serious illness or disease must be removed from the grounds. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any animals showing signs of ill health.
12. Animals and Exhibitors are showing at their own risk. TMM will not be held responsible for any injury, death, sickness, or complication that may arise from showing at the KCYAEC to you or your animals. Entering this show will indicate the exhibitor has read and understands all the rules, agrees to follow all the rules, and holds no accountability to the show or show committee for anything gone wrong, lost, stolen, injured, sick, or dead.

13. Pens—Pens are \$10 each for members and \$15 for non-members. Pens must be cleaned out before you leave. The pens are 5x5, and the middle panels are removable to make a 5x10. We recommend putting down a tarp and shavings for easy clean-up. A dumpster will be available to deposit used bedding.

14. **Youth Showmanship:** Showmanship will take place on Saturday at 3:00 p.m. No fee. Sign up at check in. Showmanship is open to all youth regardless of who owns the animal they are exhibiting.
