Texas Mini Milkers West Texas Waltz MDGA Show Rules

TMM shows are sanctioned by MDGA, and their show rules shall govern. See MDGA Show Rules above.

- 1. Entry fees are non-refundable. Entry fees are per goat per ring. TMM Members are \$10 per goat per ring and \$15 for non-members. Entries must be completed and paid for through the Showman App. To become a TMM member, visit our website. If you select member prices on the Showman App and you are not a member, you will be invoiced for the \$25 member fee. All entries are nonrefundable. We will allow substitutions at check-in with no additional fee.
- 2. TMM West Texas Waltz show is separately sanctioned for Junior Does (AOM), Combined Does (AOM), and Combined Bucks (AOM).
- 3. Arrival and check-in will begin Saturday, September 13th, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. All juniors and bucks should be checked in by 2:00 p.m. on Saturday. For Sunday arrivals, Senior Doe check-in will occur Sunday morning from 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. All Senior Does competing on Sunday should be checked in by 7:30 a.m.
- 4. The base date for calculating age is September 13, 2025.
- 5. There is no pre-show milk-out. Please be sure your does are shown with a comfortable amount of milk in their udders.
- 6. Exhibitors should dress appropriately. A white shirt and white pants or skirt are preferred, but a black or dark blue pair of pants is acceptable.
- 7. Registration certificates or a pending registration email are required for all animals entered in the show. No photocopies or electronic copies allowed.
- 8. Make sure your goats are tattooed and that their tattoos match their registration papers. We do have a microchip reader available for those animals that may have faded or illegible tattoos and are also microchipped; however, the microchip number must be listed on the animal's registration papers, and it must match the microchip that is being read. Animals will not be tattooed on the day of the show.
- 9. Campfires, glass containers, and fireworks are not permitted at Ace Arena. All milk must be disposed of in the restroom sinks or toilets. No smoking. Dogs must always be on a leash, and they are not allowed in the goat pen area.
- 10. Please come prepared with tie chains, especially if you are showing in more than one class. We will have volunteers to assist you, but they may not always be available to help. Ask for help when checking in if you need assistance with showing.
- 11. In addition, please keep ALL first and second-place animals ringside so that we may quickly get them in the Champion lineup.
- 12. Health papers are not required, but animals showing signs of serious illness or disease must be removed from the grounds. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any animals showing signs of ill health.
- 13. Animals and Exhibitors are showing at their own risk. TMM will not be held responsible for any injury, death, sickness, or complication that may arise from showing at the ACE Arena to you or your animals. Entering this show indicates that the exhibitor has read and understands all the rules, agrees to follow them, and holds the show and its committee harmless for any issues that may arise, including loss, theft, injury, illness, or death.
- 14. Pens—Pens are \$5 each for members and \$10 for non-members. Pens must be cleaned out before you leave. We recommend putting down a tarp and shavings for easy clean-up. A dumpster will be available to deposit used bedding. NO PELLET BEDDING.

15. Receipt of entry will be an agreement by the exhibitor to abide by the show rules. By entering the TMM West Texas Waltz, you indicate that you have read and understood these show rules and agree to comply with them.
