Texas Mini Milkers West Texas Waltz ADGA Show Rules

- 1. Entry fees are non-refundable. Entry fees are per goat per ring. TMM Members are \$10 per goat per ring and \$15 for non-members. Entries must be completed and paid for through the Showman App. To become a TMM member, visit our website. If you select member prices on the Showman App and you are not a member, you will be invoiced for the \$25 member fee. All entries are nonrefundable. We will allow substitutions at check-in with no additional fee.
- 2. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association. ADGA rules shall govern. Sanctioned for Bucks.
- 3. Arrival and check-in will begin Friday, September 26th, from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. For Saturday arrivals, check-in will occur from 6:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. All goats competing should be checked in by 8:30 a.m. on Saturday.
- 4. The base date for calculating age is September 27, 2025.
- 5. Exhibitors should dress appropriately. A white shirt and white pants or skirt are preferred, but a black or dark blue pair of pants is acceptable.
- 6. Registration certificates or a stamped duplicate are required for all animals entered in the show. No photocopies or electronic copies allowed. Original registration certificates or a valid stamped duplicate must be presented to the Show Secretary before judging shall begin (ADGA rule X1-A-6).
- 7. Make sure your goats are tattooed and that their tattoos match their registration papers. For microchip identification for faded or illegible tattoos, exhibitors are responsible for providing the microchip reader. The microchip number must match the number listed on the animal's registration papers. Animals cannot be tattooed on the day of the show.
- 8. Campfires, glass containers, and fireworks are not permitted at Galveston County Fairgrounds. No smoking. Dogs must always be on a leash, and they are not allowed in the goat pen area.
- 9. Please come prepared with tie chains, especially if you are showing in more than one class. We will have volunteers to assist you, but they may not always be available to help. Ask for help when checking in if you need assistance with showing.
- 10. In addition, please keep ALL first and second-place animals ringside so that we may quickly get them in the Champion lineup.
- 11. Health papers are not required, but animals showing signs of serious illness or disease must be removed from the grounds. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any animals showing signs of ill health.
- 12. Animals and Exhibitors are showing at their own risk. TMM will not be held responsible for any injury, death, sickness, or complication that may arise from showing at the Galveston County Fairgrounds to you or your animals. Entering this show indicates that the exhibitor has read and understands all the rules, agrees to follow them, and holds the show and its committee harmless for any issues that may arise, including loss, theft, injury, illness, or death.
- 13. Pens—Pens are \$5 each for members and \$10 for non-members. Pens must be cleaned out before you leave. We recommend putting down a tarp and shavings for easy clean-up. A dumpster will be available to deposit used bedding. NO PELLET BEDDING.
- 14. Receipt of entry will be an agreement by the exhibitor to abide by the show rules. By entering the TMM Beach Buck Boogie, you indicate that you have read and understood these show rules and agree to comply with them.
