Somich FAMILY

t has been a tough past few years for the Somich family, but they are living life with strength and resilience and are happy to be making a new start in Fairbanks Ranch!

Tami Somich, son Alexander or "Alex," 15, and daughter Isabelle or "Izzy," 11, moved to our neighborhood last year, following the loss of their husband and father, Nick Somich after an eight-year battle with melanoma. Before his death, Nick worked hard to make sure his family could move forward in the happiest way possible. "That's why we are in Fairbanks Ranch," explains Tami. "Nick felt this was the safest place for us to be, and he knew we would be supported by the many friends we already had in the neighborhood. Our friends really are like family." After looking at many properties together, Tami eventually purchased a charming home on Camino Acampo, choosing it for its "not too big" floor plan and ideal location. With the help of Nick's brother who lives in Murrieta, Tami gutted the home, taking down walls, raising ceilings, reframing fireplaces, and more. "It is almost done," she says, "and was a really fun project. Nick and I used to love renovating homes together, so I felt like he was with me on this project. And I know it would make him happy to see us here."

Tami and Nick grew up in a small town in western Pennsylvania. They met in middle school and knew one another casually throughout high school, though Nick was a year older. When Tami started college, she ended up running into Nick on her very first day on the huge Pennsylvania State University campus! The two became inseparable almost immediately and dated throughout their time at Penn State, becoming engaged when Tami was a senior and Nick was a recent grad working on Wall Street. They married soon after Tami graduated with a BA in elementary education and spent the next four years in New York City. There, Tami earned a master's degree in curriculum instruction at Fordham University and began a teaching career. When Nick decided to go back to school to earn his MBA at Wharton, the couple moved to Philadelphia and Tami taught at a private elementary school in Wilmington Delaware, for two years. Then it was off to Chicago for four years, where Nick worked for Citadel. "Chicago was one of my favorite places we lived," says Tami. "We had Alex by this point and lived right in the city. It was easy to get around and there was so much to do." Then, another job in hedge fund management lured Nick back to New York City. But this time, the young family – now with two children – settled in Darien, CT. They remained there for four years until Nick was diagnosed with melanoma.

"Nick was working crazy hours and was under so much stress," recalls Tami. "When he got sick, it caused us to really evaluate how we wanted to live our lives. We decided nothing is more important than time with family." They decided to move to San Diego and Nick gave his notice at work. To his surprise, his firm did not want to let him go! They allowed him to keep his same job and work from home. The family moved to San Diego and settled in the Crosby Estates. For the next five years, life was good. Nick's cancer remained Stage 1. At his five-year scan, however, they learned the cancer had spread, jumping to Stage 4. From there, it was a tough three-year fight until he passed away in October 2019.

Now, Tami stays busy as the owner/designer at Somich Design. She started the company recently in honor of Nick and is already so busy she must turn some business away. Tami designs both commercial and residential spaces and has begun staging homes for sale, as well. When not creating beautiful spaces, she enjoys going for walks through the neighborhood with friends, playing pickleball, or reading a good book, which she says, "doesn't happen often enough!" Of course, nothing is better than spending time with her kids.

Izzy is in fifth grade at Solana Santa Fe School. She is a ballet dancer and was featured in last month's issue of *Fairbanks Living*. Alex is a freshman at Torrey Pines High School. He is excited to be playing freshman baseball for Torrey Pines, and is glad to finally be able to set foot on campus after having to study from home for the past year! In his spare time, Alex volunteers with Miracle League in Solana Beach. Miracle League provides children with special needs the opportunity to play baseball in an organized league.

The Somich family also supports Camp Kesem, a camp for children that have a parent with cancer or have lost a parent to cancer. And, they support Melanoma.org, in honor of Nick.

We hope this young family enjoys many happy years in Fairbanks Ranch.







Experience PACIFIC RIDGE SCHOOL

Talk with TJ

For the first time in the history of my "Talk with TJ" column, I'll be covering an incredible organization, Pacific Ridge School, a sponsor of *Fairbanks Living*. As an eighth-grade student of Pacific Ridge, I've experienced the way the school's unique way of teaching students compares to other schools. Rather than sixteen of us being seated in the classroom at separate desks, we actually all sit at one round table together so that the teacher can have a conversation with all of us in one big area. This also allows students to have a more open discussion, which our principal, Dr. Ogle, calls the Harkness experiment.

The nice thing about Harkness is that it allows for many interesting conversations to flourish as everyone is allowed to have their own opportunity to speak as no one has to raise their hands but rather can pitch in whenever someone finishes. Since I have always been a very talkative person, Harkness is very beneficial to me academically for it allows me to earn lots of points on in-class assignments and class participation than I normally would get in a normal classroom environment. Of course, the Harkness method has been modified during COVID-19 over Zoom, but nonetheless, this is a big selling point for the school.

Another great thing about Pacific Ridge is their willingness to give you the opportunities to have new world experiences by traveling all over the world once I reach high school. Finding ways to expose us to the world, Pacific Ridge has always been an advocate for students to be a member of the global community,

meaning we should always strive to learn about the world around us, in turn bettering ourselves to make it a better place.

One of the things I loved in seventh grade was when they brought two speakers from two different continents together to speak to us. By the time they finished speaking, what they said changed my life forever. One speaker was from Africa, and she was a woman who told a story of how she sacrificed everything to get an education and having to deal with people telling her she was nothing, abusing her, and being treated like she was nothing more than a servant. She prevailed in the end and reminded us of the importance of education. The last speaker was perhaps the one I never thought I would meet, a woman who is a Holocaust survivor. Her story was so heartfelt, one of sadness yet hope, tragedy yet triumph, which reminded me of the savagery of men, as well as the beauty of humanity.

It's easy to see why I enjoy being a student at Pacific Ridge so much. It gives us the opportunity to learn lessons through not only the lens of classroom instruction but also through the opportunity to meet people living with real-life experiences. Pacific Ridge strives to come up with new ways to teach that are interesting and interactive and I am lucky to be a middle school student there!



INTRODUCES US TO "KARMANN"

Part of a pair of 55s

It was 1955 and the world was getting ready to discover a young rock and roll superstar that would change the world forever. "Of course, I'm an Elvis Fan! Who isn't?" states Brett Soliday. As we learned in the last issue when featuring his '55 Corvette (Shirlene), his love of all things from the '50s started at a young age and has never left. "I grew up in the '80s and as iconic as that genre was, nothing compares to the '50s. The music, the style, and, of course, the cars."

As a teenager, Brett developed his love of the "People's Car" aka the

Wagon of the Folks or Volkswagen. "When you're young and have no money, VW's were the car of choice. Easy to repair, and cheap to purchase." A lot has changed since then. Having been a part of Southern California's original "Cal Bug" scene in the early '80s, Brett saw the extraordinary surge in popularity. "After the '80s, many Japanese collectors started buying up all of the VWs around the world. This really drove the costs up and suddenly people were thinking differently about these cars." Brett purchased "Karmann" named appropriately after

its builder who became famous for manufacturing Kabriolets and his notorious Ghia for Volkswagen. "Unlike my Corvette, there are so many things I want to do to this car. I just purchased a set of rear fender skirts, an original St. Christopher horn button, vintage tail pipes, to name a few. There is this huge underground of VW people all over the world that have original memorabilia and options for these cars. It's just insane." Karmann came with the original service books, tool kit, and paperwork from Wolfsburg, Germany. It even has a U.S. Armed Services license plate, since it was previously owned by a U.S. Army Colonel in Germany. "I have always wanted a vintage Karmann Kabriolet with semaphores (instead of blinkers on the fenders, the semaphore is a flag that pops out of the side of the car and blinks, and then closes once the blinker is turned off.). I knew those were next to impossible to get, especially in mint condition, so it took me a long time to find her."


Having searched for over a decade, Brett finally found the perfect Kab. "You cannot drive this car anywhere without people giving you the thumbs up. VWs are a true cult classic and they just make people smile, however, with its whopping 36 horsepower and cashbox transmission, this is not a car that will get you anywhere fast," jokes Brett. Love them or hate them, these hard-to-find Beetles (especially the convertibles) are more popular than ever. "I never thought in a million years I'd see the day when Volkswagens would sell for six figures but it has, and the prices are only going up. So much for these cars being cheap!"

chef's corner

HAIGHT STREET SPINACH SALAD

Years ago, when we lived in Northern California, I attended a fundraiser for the local high school. Similar to a Las Damas event, it was a garden tour, but at each house, the host had an appetizer, mini-sandwich, salad, or dessert to share. At the end, you could purchase the cookbook with all the recipes, and I really liked this salad.

Spinach contains non-heme iron, which is not easily absorbed. A simple solution to absorb the non-heme iron is to add a vitamin C component. Hence, strawberries, which are an excellent source of vitamin C.

SALAD:

- 10 ounces fresh spinach
- 1 pint fresh strawberries

CARAMELIZED PECANS:

- 1 cup sugar
- 4 tablespoons water
- 1 cup pecans

POPPY SEED DRESSING:

- 2 green onions, chopped
- ½ cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon dry mustard
- 1/3 cup vinegar
- 1 cup salad oil (of choice avocado, olive oil, grapeseed, etc.)
- 1 ½ tablespoons poppy seeds

SALAD: Wash greens carefully and dry thoroughly. Wash and hull strawberries and cut them into slices.

CARAMELIZED PECANS: Combine sugar, water, and pecans in a skillet. Slowly cook over low heat until all the sugar is dissolved, stirring constantly until caramelized. Immediately spread out on waxed paper to cool.

DRESSING: Put green onions into a blender or food processor and mix thoroughly, then add the sugar, salt, mustard, and vinegar, blending. Slowly add the oil, while blending. Stir in poppy seeds and refrigerate.

Assembly: Tear spinach into bite-size pieces. Combine spinach, strawberries, and pecans, pour dressing over all and toss.
