

A Giant Step Forward!

Rep. Nicole Macri's bill, 2SHB 2384 - "an act relating to increasing regulatory oversight of continuing care retirement communities", is moving forward in the State Senate. This is great news.

Tuesday, February 24th, the Senate Health and Long-Term Care Committee, led by Senator Annette Cleveland, unanimously passed 2SHB 2384. The bill now moves on to the Senate Rules Committee. From there the bill will go to the Senate floor for a vote.

2SHB 2384 represents an incremental improvement in financial transparency. It acknowledges in law the relevance and importance of actuarial analysis and state oversight of CCRCs. Although the bill is limited to "Type A" CCRCs, it establishes the importance of independent financial oversight for all CCRCs.

- Your position on the bill is "PRO"
- Any statement you would like to share such as "I am urging a yes vote on the Senate Floor to protect CCRC residents"
