2024 Legislative Wrap Up Report from WACCRA's Lobbyist


The Washington State Legislative Session is over, and the various bills and budgets have been signed by Governor Inslee. Several Initiatives were considered with three being passed by the Legislature and three put forward to the voters in the November election. Five bills supported by WACCRA were passed and signed by the Governor while two bills WACCRA supported did not move forward.

There are a number of Representatives and Senators that are either retiring or seeking different offices either here in our state or that other Washington. In addition to the election of new Washington State House representatives which occurs every two years and the election of half of the Senate, a new Governor, a new Attorney General and a new Insurance Commission November's ballot should be full!
