

#### **Pastor Mark's Column**



Simon Peter told them, "I'm going fishing." They said, "We'll go with you." They set out in a boat, but throughout the night they caught nothing. - John 21:3

My mom taught me how to fish. My dad was usually busy with work (and I can guarantee you he's *still* busy with work) and didn't have much time for fishing. My mom would take me and my sister out to a bridge to go fishing. I'd take my spiderman fishing pole and fish in a small lake in my community in Texas.

We caught fish, but we always tossed them back into the lake. My mom didn't know how to cook and clean fish, and these were probably the fish you don't want to eat. It was a great time! As I reflect on those days, I wonder when I will teach my son and expose him to the valuable lessons it imparts.

I think that the story of Simon Peter would be great if it just ended right there. It would be so nice to go fishing throughout the night and catch nothing. Just enjoy some time together and just waste the day away on the lake. Fishing is a meditative practice that reveals more to us about God's creation than we intend. It isn't too long before we realize that catching fish is only secondary to the recreation itself.

This is the rare time that we can find some peace and quiet and contemplation. This is the occasion where everything melts away and there are no worries. Our souls find the same stillness as the water upon which we rest. It only makes sense that we find lessons of faith in such a practice.

We'll be exploring the lessons fishing gives us and how it applies to our faith. We'll explore how fishing can give us insight into our spiritual development.



We'll be discussing topics like diversity, discipleship, patience, and peace. So please join us this August as we explore scripture and go fishing.

We had a wonderful, HOT food drop on Tuesday, July 25. The planning and precautions kept everyone safe from the extreme



heat. Canopies, refrigerated trailer, refrigerated blankets, ice packs, lots and lots of water, rotating shifts inside and outside, all helped keep our volunteers and our food safe.

We had additional volunteers which really helped with the giving of 200 "*Blessing Bags*" containing needed items not covered at the food shelf; such as paper products, personal hygiene, cleaning and laundry items. These bags were provided by Hearts-to-Hands and very much appreciated.


