Essential Spiritual Lent, our Sun-**Practices**

Throughout day sermons will guide us through essen-

tial spiritual practices—Prayer, Scripture, Forgiveness, Generosity, and Praise. These are not just individual actions but a rhythm of life that draws us closer to God and transforms how we engage with the world.

James reminds us that faith is more than understanding; it is something we embody. Spiritual practices are how we move beyond hearing God's word to living it.

- ♦ When we pray, we open ourselves to God's presence.
- ♦ When we engage scripture, we allow it to shape our hearts.
- ♦ When we forgive, we reflect the mercy we have received.
- ♦ When we give, we participate in God's abundance.
- ♦ When we praise, we acknowledge the goodness of God that sustains us.



Lent is a season of preparation, a time when we intentionally draw near to God through disciplines that renew our hearts. It is a season of reflection, repentance, and transformation. Whether we take on new practices or let go of what distracts us, Lent invites us to realign our lives with Christ. In these weeks leading to Easter, we are reminded that faith is not passive—it is lived out daily in the ways we seek God and love others.

Each of these practices, taken on its own, strengthens us. Together, they form a foundation that helps us navigate both the joys and challenges of life. Like any habit, they require intention and commitment. But in practicing our faith, we discover that God is already at work in us, transforming our hearts and deepening our connection to Christ.



This season, I invite you to reflect on what spiritual practices shape your faith. What rhythms help you draw near to God? What next step is calling you deeper into discipleship? Let's journey together, not just as hearers, but as doers of the word.


Montrose UMC Book Club


EASTER PLANT DONATION FORM 2025 EASTER IS ON SUNDAY, APRIL 20th

FINANCE UPDATE



Hello Friends,

We are hopefully nearing the end of winter soon - cannot wait. One item I was asked to provide going forward is a summary of monthly giving and expenses, below you will find the details for January. Please note, income can often

be sporadic as some individuals give annually, so make sure you are looking at this on an annualized basis.

January Income:

General Fund \$7,633.17. This includes Designated Giving, Apportionments, Palabra Viva rent, Special Offerings, etc. Building Maintenance giving - \$3,638.63.

January Expenses:

Salary items \$4,221.60. This is for pastor, secretary, janitor, pianist, and all benefit costs. Board of Trustees \$4,221.60. This includes all utilities, maintenance agreements, repair expenses (water heater for January). There will be other smaller expenses but these are the two biggest categories.

FE-ED REPORT FOR THE FEBRUARY 25, 2025 FREE FOOD DISTRIBUTION

We had a wonderful warm day to hold our February food drop. Everyone was happy to enjoy lighter clothing and no hats or gloves needed.

Our students from the Phoenix Learning Center were so helpful and eager to work, it made for lots of smiles and laughter!

We celebrated 3 February birthdays: Steve Hayes, Mary Lytle, and Russ Johnson with cake and song!

This was our first advertised new 2 pm start time, which went well but it will take awhile for people to become accustomed to it.

We had an abundance of good food! Apples, Cabbage, Carrots, Red & Sweet Potatoes, Onions, Tomatoes, Spaghetti noodles, Tomato Sauce, Ground Turkey, Biscuits, Milk and even Eggs!

We had 40 volunteers giving 117.75 hours of work!

We were blessed with additional food from the Community:

- The Waverly Food Shelf donated 400 lbs. of food.
- Dollar General in Montrose donated 5 lbs. of Hanes Kids Cotton Face Masks.
- Buffalo Food Shelf donated 70 lbs. of various Hot Sauces


