Pastor Mark's Column

"Whatever you do, whether in speech or action, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus and give thanks to God the Father through him."

- Colossians 3:17



Gratitude is something that gets easier as you get older. As a kid, I would have extreme difficulty writing simply five sentences in a thank you letter. Now as an adult, I could write an entire essay about how thankful I am. The more experience I have of how precious my family and friends are; the more I'm grateful for everything they give me. This month is a time of stewardship and a time of gratitude. We will be looking deeper at these themes in our November sermon series: Gratitude.

The one thing that isn't easy about gratitude is sometimes remembering to either give gratitude or even why we should be grateful. It's easy to be able to write a thank you letter for a birthday or Christmas gift, but it's more difficult to be grateful for the everyday gift of life and love. Each month we're reminded of the price Christ paid for our sins and we express gratitude. But Christ expects more than gratitude, Christ expects us to be able to share it with others. We're supposed to share that blessing of life and love with those who really need it. That's the mission of the church: to make disciples of all nations so that all may come to know Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. To me, that means we need to share that good news! We need to share that love and grace that invites each and every one of us into a relationship with God.



That's why we'll also be talking about stewardship. Every November every church in the world makes this reminder of stewardship, and for me stewardship is an investment. Just like in the stock market, you devote your time and money to a future you believe in and are a part of. If we are grateful for our faith and believe in the mission and future of the church, then this is the time to invest.



As you think about the life of the church over the past year and as you look forward into the future I have to

ask: where do you stand? There are more than just financial ways to invest in the church. As we look to the future, we need to make sure that everyone is all in! There will be more opportunities for volunteering and making an impact. Are you grateful enough to spread that same hope in our faith to volunteer? Are you invested enough in the future of the church? It's a challenge we all face, and this month we'll face it together.



Finance Update

Hello Everyone,

A quick update from the Finance Team. Thank you to everyone for your response on our parking lot "drive". This project is currently on hold as we've discovered we have some major elevator repairs that need to happen soon, to the tune of \$29,000. We have contacted our insurance company and filed a claim, and are waiting for an insurance adjuster to inspect the damages a recent elevator inspection showed to our elevator pit from spring rains, power outages and a burnt out sump pump motor. We expect to know in the next week or so if these repairs will be covered by insurance. If not, we will have to cover these repair costs.

In mid-October it was noticed that the air compressor has been running a lot, so we had the sprinkler company out to check for another air leak in the sprinkler system. Low and behold, they feel we have another leak in the sanctuary - east side of the building. We're waiting to hear what the repair cost will be for that. The sprinkler on the west side of the sanctuary was repaired in May. As they often say, once the mortgage is paid, it seems like everything starts to breakdown!

Fingers crossed, this is it for quite a while!

In the December newsletter we will have our annual "fill the Christmas Tree" drive. This year's focus will be Apportionments, as we are way behind on our annual collections towards this, and possibly the elevator repairs. Your support will be appreciated.

We were very concerned when we placed our order with SHH on Tuesday, October 18th, as there was little available to purchase. There would have only been yogurt, carrots, eggplant, milk, and pet food - that was all! FE-ED was able to secure fresh eggs on Friday, October 21st.

Many prayed on this and low and behold, Untiedt's committed to a bounty of fresh produce on Wed., Oct. 19th! We got great breads from *Great Grains*, 12 boxes of bread from the Waverly Food Shelf, and meats from the Buffalo Food Shelf. We received a donation of 150 boxes of Noodle Soup, and MUMC donated candy. We had a bounty of food proving that God does Provide!!

We were blessed to have volunteers come on Monday to receive the produce from Untiedt's, and return on Tuesday to help pack and distribute boxes.

We were able to celebrate Bob Prestidge's birthday with Connie Nelson's chili recipe made by her son Bill. The chili was so good and reminded us of this tradition Connie always observed of "Chili for Bob".

We also retired Connie's FE-ED name tag. We miss her dedicated commitment to providing food for everyone and making certain that we followed all procedures and rules with a **smile**.
