



Board of Trustees Update

UPCOMING PROJECTS:

- Mon., Oct. 9th thru Wed., Oct. 11th Concrete work begins in the front of the church replacing cracked stairs and slabs. Then back entryway and sidewalk slabs will be replaced. THERE WILL BE LIMITED ACCESS TO THE BUILDING DURING CONCRETE WORK.
- Mon., Oct. 16th Frontier Fire Protection will perform water test in sanctuary to find air leak(s). Since the church does not have the funds to replace air system, we'll have to address the leaks. This test and any repairs will impact the sanctuary for a week or two.
- We are getting a quote to replace the black railings on the right side as you enter the church, these are the ones rusted and unsafe. We hope to have the railing replaced before winter
- The roof was inspected on Fri., Sept. 22nd and minimal damage to ROOF was found, however there was some hail damage to a few others areas of the building. We will contact insurance company to see if damage warrants an adjuster to come out. Then what would/could be covered by insurance.

September 26th Food Drop Report

Huge quantities of food and workers! We had an abundance of food from Second Harvest Heartland, Untiedt's, and the Buffalo & Waverly Food Shelves. We had cauliflower, green peppers, onions, corn, bags of grapefruits, cereal, chips and more! We were so blessed to have about 30 stu-

dents from the Phoenix Learning Center help us.

The rain held off until we were placing the boxes in the vehicles. We served our largest number of people and used all the food boxes we had prepared. You can tell the need is increasing. Thank you to everyone who made this drop a success! We had 48 volunteers for a total of 170.74 volunteer hours!

t Our community contributed a lot of extras:

- 3,000 Lbs. of fresh produce from Untiedt's.
- 2,130 Lbs. from the Buffalo Food Shelf.
- 100 Lbs. of bread products from Waverly Food Shelf.

September Statistics:

- 11,902 Lbs. of food from SHH
- 209 Families served
- 612 Individuals served
- 13 New, first time families
- 42 Veterans served (highest number in our history!)
