

Statement From the Chair of Progress For Wildwood PAC

My name is Larry Feuerstein and I was recently elected Chair of the Progress For Wildwood PAC. I've been a resident of Wildwood's Ward 1 for 17 and 1/2 years. Previous to that I lived for five years in Reston, VA, reportedly America's first modern planned community.

I've always been an interested, involved citizen in the communities where I've lived, with a keen interest in achieving the principles of "good government."

In Wildwood I was appointed by Mayor Bowlin to the 8-member Charter Review Commission, which developed five Charter Amendment Propositions that are on the ballot for the April 3rd election. Prior to that volunteer service I was appointed by former Mayor Woerther to the 23-member Master Plan Advisory Committee, which delivered an updated Wildwood Master Plan that was adopted by the city in 2016.

As a result of these experiences, I consider myself very well versed in the master planned community concept and have been a recent participant in the mandated updates of Wildwood's two most significant controlling documents under two different mayoral regimes. I understand the details of our governance structure and I have personal experience with the marked contrasts between the current city government and its most recent predecessor.

Please join me and the PAC organization in promoting continued "smart progress" for Wildwood, in full compliance with the sacrosanct Master Plan and Charter.
