

## FREQUENTLY ASKED PAC QUESTIONS

### 1) What is a PAC?

A PAC is a committee formed by a person or group of persons for the purpose of supporting or opposing candidates or ballot measures and which is not formed, controlled or directed by a candidate or candidate committee.

### 2) Where does a PAC derive its legal authority?

PACs are authorized by the MO Constitution and statutes and are regulated by the MO Ethics Commission (MEC).

### 3) Why a PAC?

A PAC allows a group of like-minded citizens to focus election activities on a particular candidate or set of candidates and/or ballot propositions that support the group's point of view.

### 4) Have there ever been other PACs in Wildwood?

Yes. According to official MEC records other PACs have previously been formed with respect to Wildwood elections.
