

RYSC Coach Toolkit-Contacting your team

Task

- 1 Prior to making calls, secure location & time for team meeting
 - A local park or pizza place can work, but note that they fill up fast.
 - Allow for about 1-1.5 hours for this meeting
- 2 Contact within 3 days of receiving roster (if possible)
 - Take notice if there are parents living at separate numbers.
 - Unless otherwise noted you will need to call both parents.
- 3 Introduce yourself to new players & welcome back the returners
 - Make them all feel welcome as one team
 - Refrain from referring to the players as new or returning as you them to feel as one team not new players & returning players
- 4 Provide information regarding team meeting
 - You have a lot of calls to make. So if they have questions about practices, games, etc., explain that these details will be covered at the team meeting.
- 5 If you receive offers for volunteers, make a note as you will need them later
 - Hold off soliciting for volunteers until the team meeting.
 It is easier to obtain their support when you ask for it face to face.
 - Get as much help as you can. If the parents are helping they are invested and less apt to complaing!
