PLAYER SUSBSTITUTION PROCESS AS MODIFIED FOR 2015 FOR BOTH CCSL AND CPL LEAGUES

Players may be substituted at the following times:

- 1. Prior to a throw-in, in your favor. *Competitions may allow substitutions by either team if the team in possession of the ball substitutes.
- 2. Prior to a goal kick, by either team.
- 3. After a goal, by either team.
- 4. After an injury, when the referee stops play, by either team.
- 5. At half time.
- **6.** When the Referee stops play to caution a player, only the cautioned player may be substituted, prior to the restart of play.
- 7. The number of substitutes shall be unlimited. A substitute shall not enter the field of play until he/she has been given a signal to do so by the Referee.
