



RECREATIONAL SEND OFF NOTIFICATION

When a Player Sendoff or a Coach dismissal occurs in a Recreational Game U-14 or below or CPL (U-16/19) the following process is to occur:

- 1-The Referee retains the Player/Coaches pass, and the game card.
- 2-The Referee notifies his/her respective Club Referee Director (the same day).
- 3-The Referee goes to www.d6soccer.org and under Referee fills out the 24 Send Off Report.
- 4-The Referee gives the Club Referee Director the Player/Coach pass, the game card, and the filled out 24 hour send off report (Referee keeps a copy). Within one day of send off/dismissal.
- 5-The Club Referee Director inspects the documents, and forwards/sends them onto one of the below listed PAD Chairs (within 24 hours of his/her receiving the documents):
