Lake Sylvia Recreation Area



Just a short drive west of Little Rock in the Ouachita National Forest, this serene 18-acre lake is noted for its swimming, fishing, and many outdoor recreation opportunities.

The park's trail system offers visitors opportunities to hike, enjoy a nature walk, or connect with the Ouachita National Recreation Trail for a backpacking experience. The park is also popular with trail runners and gravel grinders.

Park visitors can also enjoy a swimming beach, picnic sites, playground, bicycle pump track, and interpretive programs.



Looking for a place to stay overnight in the great outdoors? The park has 14 campsites with water and electricity, 8 primitive sites, and two group tent camping sites.



The park also offers 7 camper cabins that can be reserved online or by calling. Not full-service cabins, the camper cabins provide more of a rustic camping experience.

The park offers campsites with water & electricity, a boat ramp, playground and picnic spots.

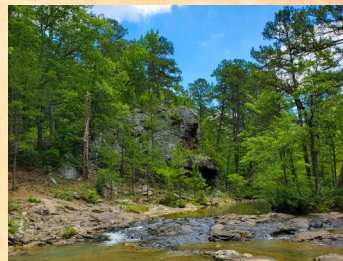
