Meet the Guest Speaker: Olivier Turina

Olivier Turina will be speaking to us about "The Orchids of the Catasetum Alliance and How to Grow Them". His orchids have received several AOS awards. The latest was this July for Catasetum Spot Me awarded by the AOS West Palm Beach Judging Center.

Olivier is a hobbyist with a true passion/obsession for orchids. He moved to Fort Lauderdale from his hometown Brussels, Belgium, in 2005 and fell in love with orchids at the 2013 Fort Lauderdale society orchid show.



With a collection of 350+ orchids, Olivier focuses on species and primary hybrids (75% of his orchids). He is particularly fond of Catasetums, Stanhopeas, Gongoras, Tricocentrums and Oncidiums in general as well as Cattleyas. He also grows Vandas, Phalaenopsis and Dendrobiums. Olivier will bring a few of his orchid divisions for our raffle table!

He has a YouTube channel called "Orchid House, Fort Lauderdale, Florida" which features growing tips for specific species or genera. He has 2,000 subscribers and more than 78,000 views.

Olivier has been a Board member of the Fort Lauderdale Orchid Society (FLOS) since 2020. When he is not taking care of his orchids, Olivier is a Realtor.
