Meet our Guest Speaker: Jason Downing, Ph.D., Director of Research at Fairchild Tropical Botanic Garden

"Florida Native Orchids"

Jason's focus at Fairchild is on orchid research, propagation, education, and conservation efforts, under The Million Orchid Project which services hundreds of schools and thousands of students each year. The orchid research with K-12 and



undergraduate students has been published in peer reviewed journals and publicized through various media outlets. To date over 500,000 native orchids have been replanted into the public landscapes of South Florida.

In 2016, Jason earned his M.S. in Environmental Science and Ph.D. in Biology at Florida International University. During his graduate tenure he held positions at Fairchild Tropical Botanic Garden and Smithsonian Environmental Research working on research to orchid ecology, mycorrhizal, genetics, and conservation. He has also been working in

orchid conservation in Florida, China, SE Asia, and the Caribbean for over 10 years.

Since 2019, Jason has served as the curator of the National Orchid Garden at Fairchild Tropical Botanic Garden. He also holds positions on the American Orchid Society Conservation Board and as affiliated faculty at Miami Dade College, Florida International University, and the University of Miami.


