Meet our Guest Speaker: Tomas Bajza

"Giant World of Miniature Orchids and **Growing in Simple Setups"**

Orchids have been Tomas's passion since his teenage years in the Czech Republic. His first attempts at growing phalaenopsis and cymbidiums were more comical than successful—until his mother bloomed his cymbidium while he was away at college by simply tossing it behind an oleander bush and watering it with the hose!

Years later, after moving to Miami, Tomas became fascinated with miniature orchids. What started with grocery-store phals and

dendrobiums only ten years ago grew into a collection of hundreds of rare micro and miniature species from around the world. Along the

way, he discovered a love for photographing these tiny blooms, which led to invitations to speak at orchid societies across the United States and publish articles internationally.

What began as a hobby has now blossomed into a successful business, Tarzane Group, as Tomas sells micro, miniature, and rare orchids. He shares his babies with the rest of the world through his website. He loves to spread knowledge about how even impossible species can thrive in Florida. For Tomas, doing what you love truly is the most rewarding thing in life!





- ★ etiolation (ee-ti-o-LAY-shun) Effect on green plants from loss of chlorophyll through exclusion of light, the normally green tissue becoming white or yellow by unmasking of carotenoids within the chloroplasts.
