# Meet our Guest Speakers: Naoki Kawamura – "Coryanthes and Its Hybrids"

Naoki will introduce us to these unusual and exotic looking orchids,

commonly called "Bucket Orchids". He is a hobbyist growing multiple genera and is known for his beautiful Vandas receiving numerous AOS awards. Naoki's passion for orchids comes from giving a white Phalaenopsis as a house-warming gift to a friend in Portland, Oregon. Visiting a boutique orchid store, he was overwhelmed with the variety of orchids, especially the multi-growths Paphiopedilum micranthum with a price tag of \$800.

He walked away that day with just the white

Phalaenopsis. Days later he went back and bought a Dendrobium. As he tried to learn how to take care of it, he joined the Oregon Orchid Society to learn more from other growers. From there his collection grew.

Living in Oregon with cold weather in the winter, all orchids were grown under lights. When a job opportunity came about and a chance to get to a warmer climate, he and his partner relocated to Venice, Florida in 2017. This move was certainly going to be a

change of environments for his orchid collection. To help them acclimate to the Florida sun he shipped all his orchids to a friend in Orlando. Currently all his orchids are grown inside the pool cage.

While in the AOS student judging program, his first assignment was "Catasetinae, Stanhopinae and Lycastinae" which he had never tried to grow. Naoki strives to learn more and more about orchids and looks to find what is the best way to grow orchids. Curiosity has now become his passion as you'll see from his presentation on Coryanthes.

#### ★ Orchidist's Word of the Month from the AOS

- ★ Coryanthes (ko-ree-AN-theez) A genus of 44 species of epiphytes with extraordinary flowers from the American tropics commonly called bucket orchids, related to Stanhopea and Gongora, it was described by Hooker in 1831, the name derived from the Greek meaning "helmet flower" in reference to the helmet-shaped epichile of the lip.
