FEBRUARY MEETING:

The Genus Dendrobium

Best ways to get rid of pests:

- Good air flow
- High humidity Water underneath of leaves (mites)
- Beneficial insects
 Lady Bugs, Green lacewings, Predatory mites

Alcohol mix

- 1 part rubbing alcohol 1 part 409 2 parts water

Hydrogen peroxide (insects, snails/slugs, rot)

Systemic insecticides (Orthene, Merit, Orthenex, Malathion, Mavrik)

★ Orchidist's Word of the Month from the AOS

- ★ Encyclia (en-SIK-lee-ah) A genus of about 240 Neotropical species previously included in a broadly defined Epidendrum, sometimes known in horticulture as bulbous epidendrums. Hooker described the genus in 1828, but it wasn't until studies by Dressler in 1961 that the genus was truly established.
- ★ If you hear a term during a presentation and don't know the meaning, you can get your answers in this Orchidist's Glossary.
