# Meet our Guest Speaker: Sandi Block-Brezner

Sandi Block-Brezner is an accredited Judge and Secretary with the West Palm Beach Judging Center. She is also a member of the American Orchid Society, the Royal Horticultural Orchid Society, the Flamingo Gardens Orchid Society, and the Ft. Lauderdale Orchid Society. Sandi has served many years on the FGOS board as Recording Secretary and 1st Vice



President of Programs. Currently she is assisting Diane Rogers with the Newbie group.

Sandi began growing orchids in 2007, with a few Phalaenopsis but got her passion for Cattleyas soon after that and has grown them ever since. She also grows orchids in the Catasetinae Alliance. Sandi is a Master Gardener in Broward County and maintains a butterfly garden that is visited by six butterfly species!

Sandi's presentation will be on culture for orchids in the Cattleya alliance. We will discuss good growing habits so that you can grow Cattleyas and their relatives to the best of your ability. Much of the information in Sandi's presentation could apply to most genera grown outside in South Florida. We will focus on culture including light, water, fertilizer, pests, and diseases, growing mediums, preparation for cold weather, and preparation for storms. Sandi has received 11 AOS awards, four of which are for Cultural Merit, and one for Cultural Excellence.





## SPECIAL REQUEST



We have had several members request Bill Hodnett's Combo recipe. We sat down with Bill last week and went over this recipe, he's fine tuned it over the many years he's been growing orchids. So here it is,

Every time Bill fertilizes with either 20 20 20, or CalMag, or a type of Bloom Booster fertilizer he adds the following COMBO:


1 oz of Maxicrop (seaweed) per gallon of water

1 oz of horticultural molasses per gallon of water

1/4 teaspoon of ProTekt per gallon of water, added after all other ingredients including fertilizer and all the water have been added. ProTekt is a silicone and will turn to gel and be useless if other ingredients are not diluted completely.

Bill NO longer adds soap to his fertilizer mix.
