

Las Cruces City Golf Championship

ELIGIBILITY

The **Las Cruces City Golf Championship** is open to all Men and Women golfers who are residents of Dona Ana County. You must be at least 18 years of age and have residency in Dona Ana County. Players must have a valid USGA Handicap Index and will compete with 100% of the GHIN handicap (Net). Men's and Women's Championship flights will compete at scratch golf (no handicap required). To qualify for the Net divisions, players must have a minimum of 10 posted scores for the current year, and 6 scores posted since May 18, 2026. To qualify for the Senior Division, you must be 60+ years of age by the entry deadline, June 29, 2026.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reduce any player's handicap, retroactive before or after the completion of play of each round, as outlined by the *USGA Handicap Formula*.

This is an individual stroke play competition. The total score of the completed competition "Low Net" (100% GHIN), will determine the overall Men's, Women's and Senior's City Champion. The Men's and Women's Championship divisions will be determined by the lowest overall "Low Gross" (No Handicap) scores.

The Tournament Committee will determine divisions/flights and course set-ups. Play will be under the USGA rule of play. The Tournament Committee's decision and ruling are final, as it relates to all aspects of the tournament.

The City Golf Championship will be contested on two of the four Dona Ana County area golf courses. Register at lcgolfchamp.com.
